



# Rail Service Improvement Program

## Sydney West Overhead Wiring Upgrade

June 2025

The Rail Service Improvement Program enables a safer, more equitable, and integrated transport network where people can travel more safely, reliably, and efficiently across NSW.

### What work are we doing?

In June, we will be installing and upgrading overhead wiring infrastructure along the rail corridor.

### When and where we'll be working

Work will take place within the rail corridor at Seven Hills between Toongabbie and Blacktown.

A temporary site compound for worker parking and access will be established south of Seven Hills Station. A portion of this carpark at the eastern end will be used to conduct work activity, with access from Boomerang Place.

Federal Road south of the rail corridor will be utilised for plant and rail corridor access only.

Standard construction hours on this project are between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

### Out of hours work

In June, some work is required to take place outside standard construction hours. This work will take place between **6am Wednesday 18 June to 6pm Wednesday 25 June 2025**.

### Why we work outside of construction hours

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and construction vehicles
- increased noise from machinery and equipment, including mobile cranes, hand tools, and other plant equipment.

Please note other contractors are also working in the area.

### Managing our impacts

Work will not be continuous. We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, and every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible. This includes:

- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- ensuring lighting towers are directed downwards and away from residents
- compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to expected noise impacts.
