

Intermittent closures of Scabbing Flat Bridge

August 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Scabbing Flat Bridge will be closed intermittently between Tuesday 3 September and Thursday 5 September for essential safety maintenance and repair work.

What work are we doing?

We will be replacing girders and corbels on both approaches to the bridge, which requires the temporary closure of the bridge to all traffic.

When we'll be working

Work will take place **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 5pm**. The bridge will be closed on **Tuesday 3 September, Wednesday 4 September and Thursday 5 September** between **9am and 3pm**.

What will this mean for you?

During the closure times, all vehicles will need to follow the detour detailed below. Please note that additional bridge closures will be required as we continue to repair the bridge. We will notify you in advance of these closures.

Detour routes

Detour via Wellington:

- motorists should allow up to **25 minutes** of **extra travel time**
- **vehicles over 15 tonnes:** Detour via Renshaw McGirr Way/Suntop Road/Arthurville Road

- **vehicles under 15 tonnes:** Detour via Bushrangers Creek Road/Zaias Lane/Arthurville Road.

Detour route via Dubbo:

- motorists should allow up to **45 minutes** of **extra travel time**
- **vehicles over 15 tonnes:** Detour via Obley Road/Eulandool Road/Nubingerie Road/Terrabella Road/Arthurville Road due to the 15 tonne load limit on Benolong Bridge
- **vehicles under 15 tonnes:** Detour via Obley Road/Benolong Road/Terrabella Road/Arthurville Road.

Please allow for additional travel time depending on your destination. We have included a map for more information.

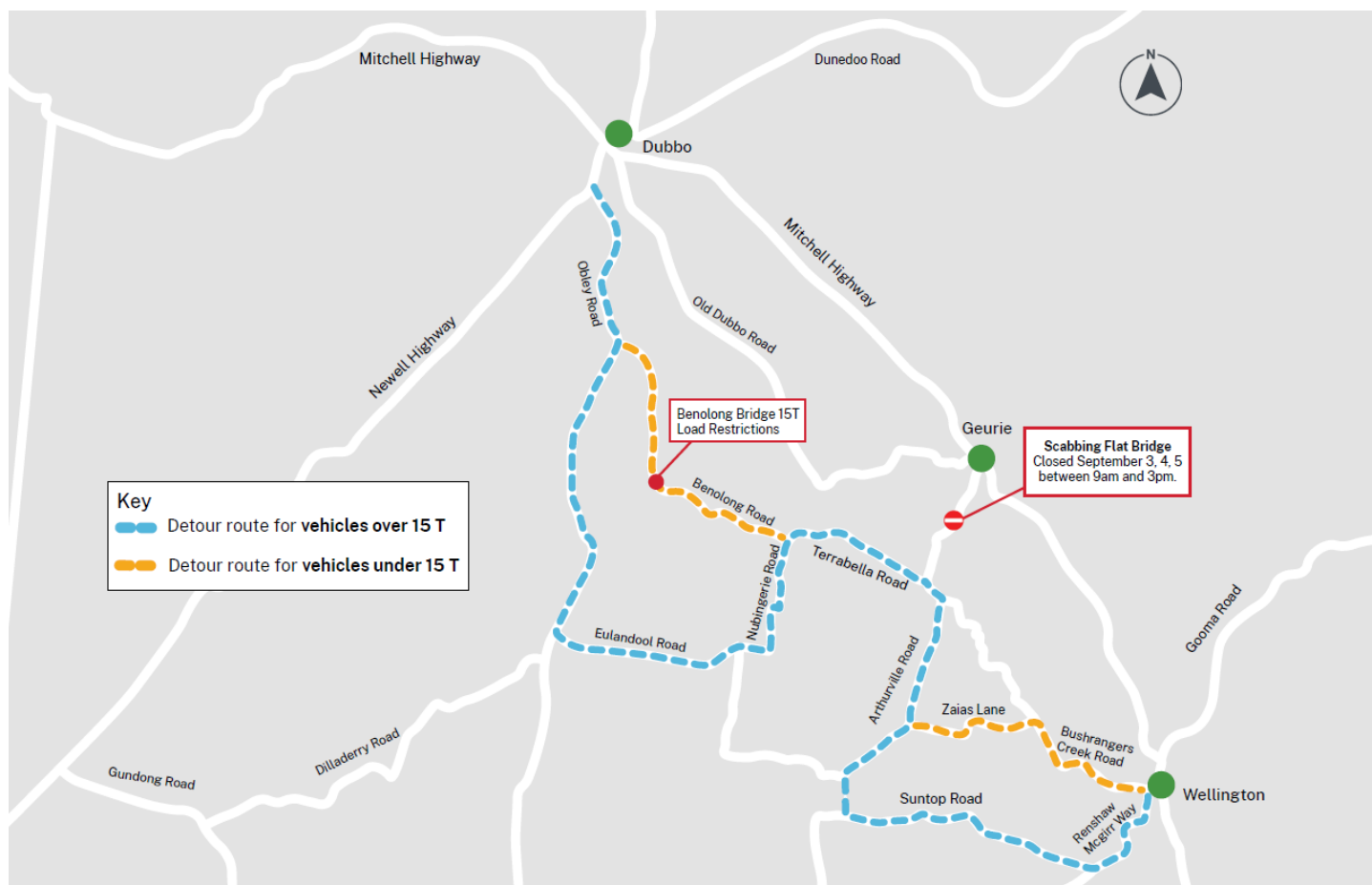
Managing our impacts
