Safety improvements on Seven Hills Road and Joseph Banks Drive, Seven Hills

Community notification

January 2025







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out pedestrian safety improvement work at the intersection of Seven Hills Road and Joseph Banks Drive, Seven Hills between Sunday 12 January and Friday 7 February 2025. This work is being completed as part of the Federal Road Safety Program.

The Federal Road Safety Program aims to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads. Since 2020, the Australian and NSW governments have invested more than \$600 million into road safety projects across NSW as part of this program.

What work are we doing?

To improve student and community safety we will install pedestrian fencing and widen the footpath at the intersection of Seven Hills Road and Joseph Banks Drive, Seven Hills.

The work will include:

- widening the footpath approaching the signalised pedestrian crossing
- installing a pedestrian fence next to the crossing in front of Seven Hills North Public School
- installing a new arrow lantern on the existing traffic light pole on Seven Hills Road
- installing new traffic light cabling under the footpath and road surface.

To install the traffic light cabling, we will need to excavate sections of the footpath and road surface. These sections will be temporarily filled in after each shift and permanently restored before the project is completed.

When are we working?

We will be working for up to 12 night shifts between Sunday 12 January and Friday 7 February 2025, weather permitting.

We will work between **Sunday** and **Thursday**, **8pm** and **5am**, the next day.

We will not work on Friday nights, Saturdays or on the Monday 27 January 2025 public holiday.

We will work up to **five nights per week** to complete the work as quickly as possible to minimise our impacts to the community.

Managing our impacts

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- completing noisier tasks, such as jackhammering, by midnight
- installing noise blankets around our work when carrying out noisy activities



using quieter equipment where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Lane and road closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place and may affect travel times.

Pedestrian access to footpaths will be maintained under the guidance of traffic controllers.

Temporary traffic lights will also be used at times whilst we install the new arrow lantern.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

We thank the community for their patience while we complete this work.
