Complete the survey and have your say to help us understand the historical, cultural and community importance of the Sunnyside Bridge.

The Sunnyside Bridge at Tenterfield (bridge) holds cultural and historical significance for the community and surrounds.

While no decision has been made on the future of Sunnyside Bridge, Transport plans to develop a heritage interpretation strategy which:

- identifies and highlights the heritage significance of the bridge; and
- captures community aspirations, values and opportunities for the bridge.

To help us develop the heritage interpretation strategy, we are consulting the community and stakeholders.

When does consultation open?

Consultation is open from **Tuesday, 3 June 2025** until **Wednesday, 2 July 2025**.

What do we want to know?

We want to know what the Sunnyside Bridge at Tenterfield means to you. Tell us the historical values, stories and themes associated with the bridge, so that we can leverage local knowledge, understanding and community aspirations for the bridge.

The information from the survey will be collated and used to identify themes and trends which Transport will consider when developing the Heritage Interpretation Strategy for this bridge.
