



Change to automatic opening of Swansea Bridge, from Sunday 1 June

The purpose of this notification is to inform all community members of an upcoming change to the operational procedures of Swansea Bridge.

New procedure

Effective from Sunday 1 June 2025, Swansea Bridge will no longer open automatically at pre-scheduled times on weekends and public holidays.

To ensure a smooth transition, we remind everyone that bookings will now be required to arrange passage through Swansea Bridge. This adjustment is aimed at improving traffic efficiency for the local area.

Please make sure to plan ahead and book your passage when necessary. For bridge opening bookings please call Marine Rescue on 02 4972 7400 or VHF Ch 16.

Thank you for your cooperation as we implement this new process. We appreciate your understanding and look forward to continuing to serve the community.

Managing our impact

We aim to manage our activities to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

- improving traffic flow by reducing unnecessary bridge openings
- improved safety due to reduced traffic stoppages.
