Bus Priority Infrastructure Program

April/May 2025

The NSW Government is committed to restoring reliability across the public transport network.

The Bus Priority Infrastructure Program delivers infrastructure improvements to address the reliability and efficiency of bus services in Greater Sydney.

Transport for NSW is starting the construction of a new bus layover facility at the corner of Railway Road and Burrows Avenue in Sydenham.

We recently issued a community update for work planned to start in March. This work was delayed due to unforeseen scheduling issues and will now take place in April and May.

Upcoming work

Throughout April and May we will be progressing with:

- installing safety barriers and signage
- demolishing specific areas within the site
- constructing a new footpath on the western side of the layover and parallel to Burrows Avenue
- installing new drainage and modifications to existing stormwater drainage
- removing two Golden Wattle trees, two Melaleuca trees and two Swamp She-oak plants.

When we will be working

Most of our work will be carried out during the day between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

During the Easter and Anzac Day period, we will not work from Friday 18 April. Work will resume on Monday 28 April. This includes no work on public holidays.

Night shifts

Some of the activities required for drainage work, including excavation, need to be carried out overnight. We will be onsite for **two consecutive night shifts** from **Sunday 11 May.**

Work will be carried out **between 8pm and 5am**. We will not work on Friday and Saturday nights.

Dates are subject to change and dependent on the weather. Please feel free to contact us for further information.

Managing our impacts

Work will be noisy at times, but we will do everything to minimise impacts by:

- carrying out noisier activities during the day for drainage work, including saw cutting
- completing noisiest work before midnight on night shifts
- not scheduling day shifts after night shifts
- turning off machinery when not in use
- using sound dampening noise blankets around work zones

not working on Sunday during the day or on public holidays.

Traffic and parking changes

Temporary traffic changes will be in place during work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

At times, traffic may be diverted, and traffic lanes closed during work activities.

We will ensure access to properties in and near the work zone is maintained. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

There will be no changes to the bus stops on Burrows Avenue, and buses will operate as usual.


