Thornton Road Bridge duplication

September 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wonnarua people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government has announced an additional \$35 million in funding towards the duplication of Thornton Road Bridge over the Main North railway. This takes the NSW Government's total investment to \$50 million.

Transport for NSW will be completing field investigations on and around Thornton Road Bridge, Thornton to prepare for future road improvements.

What work are we doing?

Transport will carry out the work, which includes field investigations and surveying underground services that will be used to inform the Thornton Road Bridge Duplication project.

When and where we'll be working

Work is scheduled to start on Monday 8 September. We will be working during the night between **7pm and 5am Monday to Thursday, for up to three weeks**, weather permitting.

From Monday 15 September we will be working during the day between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, for up to four weeks**, weather permitting.

We have included a map to show the investigation area where the work will be carried out.

What will this mean for you?

The impacts to residents and businesses in the area will be minimal. You may notice:

- night work will involve machinery and heavy vehicles moving on-site that generate noise and flashing lights
- changed traffic conditions to ensure the work zone is safe for workers and road users, including intermittent shoulder and single lane closures under traffic control and reduced 40 km/h speed limit. There will be no impact to traffic during peak periods.
- temporary footpath closures with pedestrian detours in place.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- maintaining driveway access at all times.
