



# February community update

## Tuggerah Station Upgrade

January 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darkinjung people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

### The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station. The upgrade will provide a train station that is safe, inclusive and easy to use for all passengers - especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and others who might be experiencing mobility problems.

#### Project status update

The new lifts and concourse are now open to the public. Facilities including new public restrooms are scheduled for completion in early 2025.

#### What are we doing in February 2025?

Work includes:

- general construction works, including delivery and removal of plant and materials
- adjustments to hoarding and fencing to facilitate construction works
- installation of canopy on Platform 1
- installation of canopy on Platform 2
- formwork, reinforcement and concrete pours
- crane movements to assist with construction
- earthwork activities including waste classification and removal of waste materials
- installation of utility connections for the station
- demolition of existing Station Master building
- demolition and excavation work and associated truck movements for import and export of materials
- removal and reinstatement of asphalt on Platform 1 and 2

- removal and installation of conduits
- removal of redundant cables.

We will use various items of equipment, including cranes, excavators, jack hammers, trucks including tipper, flat tray truck and hiab, elevated work platform, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, powered and manual hand tools.

Drivers will continue to see construction vehicle movements and traffic control on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road.

#### When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

#### Out of hours

From **2am Saturday 8 February to 10pm Sunday 9 February 2025**, additional plant movements will occur in the Bryant Drive commuter car park during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

There will also be additional movements on the Pacific Highway side of the station.

Work will include removal and reinstatement of asphalt on Platform 1 and 2 and removal of redundant cables and conduits.

Machinery being used includes concrete saws and excavator, grinder, and other powered hand tools.

This work will be conducted over the weekend to minimise disruption to the community, as the station is less busy during this time. However, please be aware that there will be some noise and inconvenience. Additionally, there will be no access through the station overpass during this period. Shuttle busses will be in place to provide



transportation to Pacific Highway and Bryant Drive carpark, please follow the signage.

## Changes to the commuter carpark

During February, there will be continued temporary changes to car parking arrangements at Tuggerah Station to allow for construction work.

We will be temporarily removing twelve parking spots and six accessible parking spots from the commuter car park on Bryant Drive.

## Managing our impacts

A traffic control team will be available to assist with any impacts to pedestrian movements.

This work may be noisy; however, we aim to avoid impacts to the community and the environment where possible by:

- fencing off areas for the safety of commuters
- using noise blankets and turning off machinery and equipment when not in use.
