The NSW Government and Bellingen Shire Council are investing in essential work on the Waterfall Way, Bellingen to improve road safety and journey reliability.

Transport for NSW and Bellingen Shire Council will be carrying out work on the Waterfall Way/ Hyde Street between Short Street Lane and Prince Street, Bellingen to improve drainage and road surface.

What work are we doing?

Bellingen Shire Council will be undertaking drainage improvements in the main street of Bellingen, including the installation of new pits and enhancements to stormwater treatment. These upgrades aim to improve pedestrian safety at the crossing between Coronation Street and Church Street. Additionally, Council will be resurfacing Short Street Lane with new asphalt.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out pavement work which include heavy patching and replacing failing asphalt with new asphalt.



When and where we'll be working

On Monday 17 March, service investigation and potholing will occur at the corner of Hyde Street and Church Street, over one night shift, weather permitting.

From Sunday 30 March, drainage work will be carried out on Hyde Street between Coronation Street and Church Street, over three night shifts, weather permitting.

From Sunday 6 April, pavement work will be carried out on Hyde Street between Short Street Lane and Prince Street, over five night shifts, weather permitting.

From Sunday 13 April, linemarking of the new asphalt pavement on Short Street Lane will take place over three night shifts, weather permitting.

Working hours are **6pm to 6am, Sunday to Thursday**.

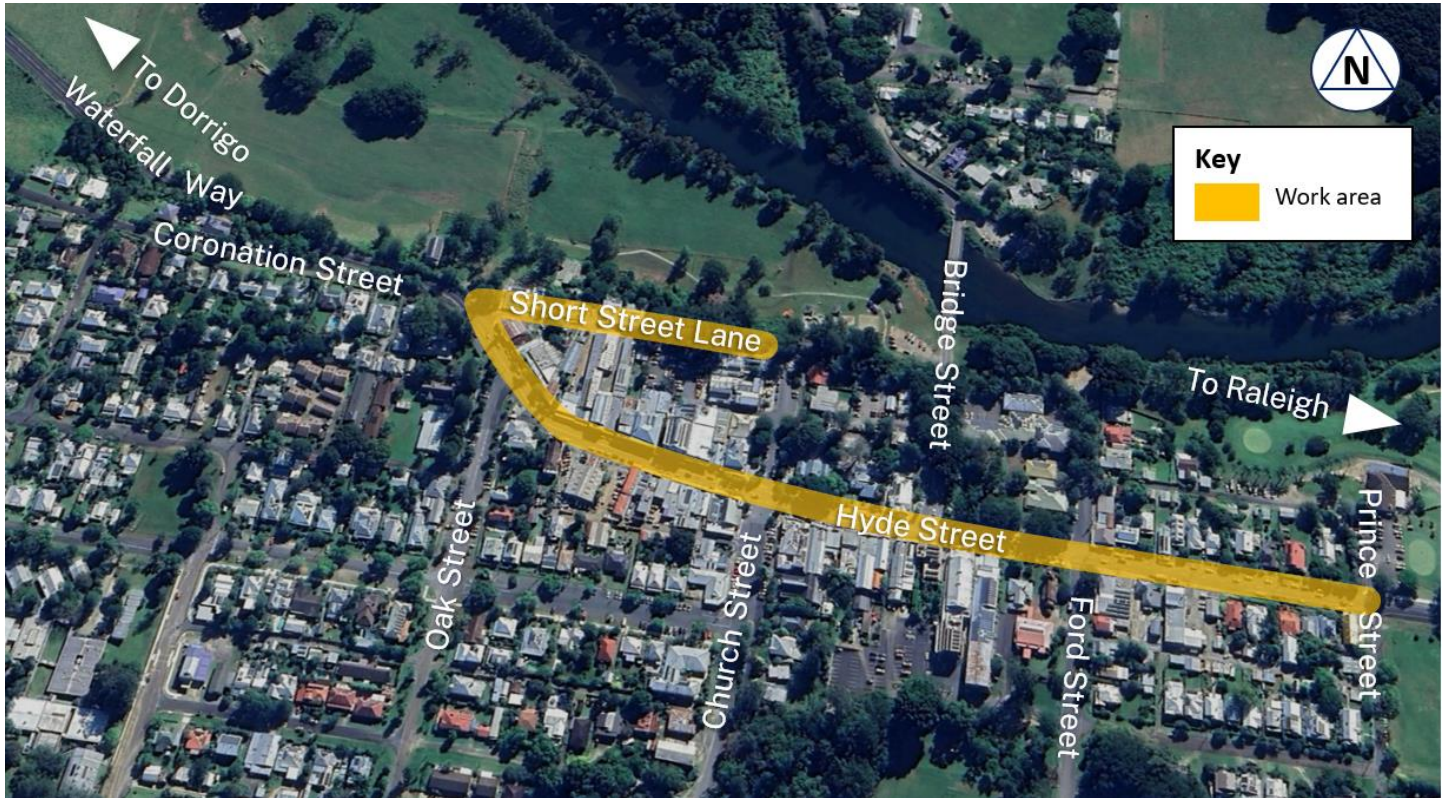
Traffic and parking impacts

Street parking on Hyde Street will be removed during working hours to allow work to be carried out safely and traffic to travel under single lane, alternating traffic flow arrangements.

A reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during working hours for the safety of workers and road users.

Motorists should plan their journey and allow up to 5 minutes extra travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

Managing our impacts

This work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise. We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Spreading out the work within the work area to minimise continuous noise and vibration in one area
- Targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- Turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Access to properties and parking will be restricted at times. The Project Team will work directly with residents and businesses to manage property access.
