


Pavement and culvert works on the Gwydir Highway, west of Moree from Monday 24 March

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in improvement and repair work on the Gwydir Highway at Browns Creek, about 51 kilometres west of Moree to improve safety and network resilience.

What work are we doing?

The first stage of work includes repair and improvement works along a two-kilometre section of the Gwydir Highway at Brown's Creek.

The work involves widening the road shoulders, pavement rehabilitation and repairs to five culverts.

Further stages of work are being planned for the future with development and design work underway.

When and where we'll be working

Work as part of the first stage of work will commence on **Monday 24 March** and is expected to take three months to complete, weather permitting.

Work hours will be from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and alternate weekends starting Saturday 29 March.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

What this will mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic control, signage, and reduced speed limits in place
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment by reducing our noise as much as possible and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic impacts


There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. This includes:

- single lane closures
- intermittent stopping
- reduced speed limit of 40km/hr during work hours. Outside work hours, the speed limit will be 60 km/h.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes of extra travel time and always keep to the posted speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
