


Work set to start on the upgrade of the Yambie Lagoon Rest Area on the Kamilaroi Highway





March 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing \$1.75 million in the upgrade of the rest area at Yambie Lagoon, about 60 kilometres east of Brewarrina on the Kamilaroi Highway.

What work are we doing?

Work will include extending the pavement to accommodate more parking for both heavy and light vehicles. We will also be installing toilet and shade facilities, bins and picnic tables at the existing eastbound site.

A similar rest area will be built directly opposite the existing rest area providing safe access for westbound vehicles.

Once completed, the rest areas will be about 230 metres in length and capable of accommodating the equivalent of five B-Triple heavy vehicles parked at any one time.

When we'll be working

Pavement work will commence on 17 March 2025 and is expected to be completed in 4 weeks, weather permitting.

Work will be completed in two shifts:

Shift 1: 7am to 6pm from Monday 17 March to Wednesday 26 March, including weekends

Shift 2: 7am to 6pm from Monday 31 March to Wednesday 9 April, including weekends

The installation of the various facilities which will be carried out later in the year.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

What this will mean for you?

The rest area will be closed to motorists and the public during construction.

We have provided a map over the page showing alternate options for rest stops along the Kamilaroi Highway.

During construction, there may be noise and dust from machinery and equipment. You will also notice traffic control, signage and reduced speed limits in place.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment by:

- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- reducing dust with the use of water spraying
- reopening the rest area to motorists following the completion of pavement works and prior to the installation of facilities.

Traffic impacts


There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

This includes a reduced speed limit of 40km/h during work hours. Outside work hours, there will be a speed limit of 60km/h for the duration of the project.
