



Bridge maintenance at Talbragar River east of Dunedoo from Monday 24 March

March 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out essential maintenance work at the bridge over the Talbragar River located around 10 kilometres east of Dunedoo on the Golden Highway to improve drainage.

What work are we doing?

The work will include:

- reinstating an access track on both sides of the bridge
- removing flood debris from the upstream side of the bridge and underneath the bridge
- cleaning the drainage outlets on the bridge kerbs to prevent water from accumulating on the bridge
- placing rocks both upstream and downstream of the bridge to protect against erosion.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working at the bridge over the Talbragar River located around 10 kilometres east of Dunedoo on the Golden Highway, east of the intersection with the Castlereagh Highway. We have provided a map over the page to show the location of the work.

Work will commence on **Monday 24 March 2025** and is expected to take up to **three weeks** to complete, weather permitting.

Working hours will be between **7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday**, and if required between **8am and 1pm on Saturday**. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

What this will mean for you

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure a safe work zone, including:

- **intermittent stopping**
- **single lane closures**
- **a reduced speed limit of 40km/h** during work hours.

Outside of work hours, both lanes will reopen and the speed limit will return to the posted speed.

Please allow up to **ten minutes** of extra travel time during the work and always follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
