

Start of preliminary works for Mitchell Highway widening east of Narromine from Monday 26 May

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will start preliminary works on the Mitchell Highway east of Narromine to prepare for future road widening.

What work are we doing?

The work will include removing vegetation and fencing activities to make way for future road widening work on the Mitchell Highway.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working on the Mitchell Highway around three kilometres east of Narromine. A map showing the location of the work area is included over the page.

Work will commence from **Monday 26 May 2025** and is expected to take up to **five days** to complete, weather permitting. Working hours will be **7am to 6pm from Monday to Friday**.

All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

We understand that the work will generate some inconvenience and we thank you for your patience.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic control and signs
- lane closures and a reduced speed limit
- workers and vehicles
- machinery and equipment
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Traffic impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure a safe work zone, including:

- intermittent stopping
- single lane closures
- a reduced speed limit of 60km/h during work hours.

Outside work hours, both lanes will reopen, and the speed limit will return to normal.

Please allow up to **five minutes of extra travel time** during the work and always follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the environment and the community.

Trees removed will be chipped and the woodchips made available to Taronga Western Plains Zoo for use as mulch, with any remaining woodchips disposed of at a registered waste facility.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Location of work area

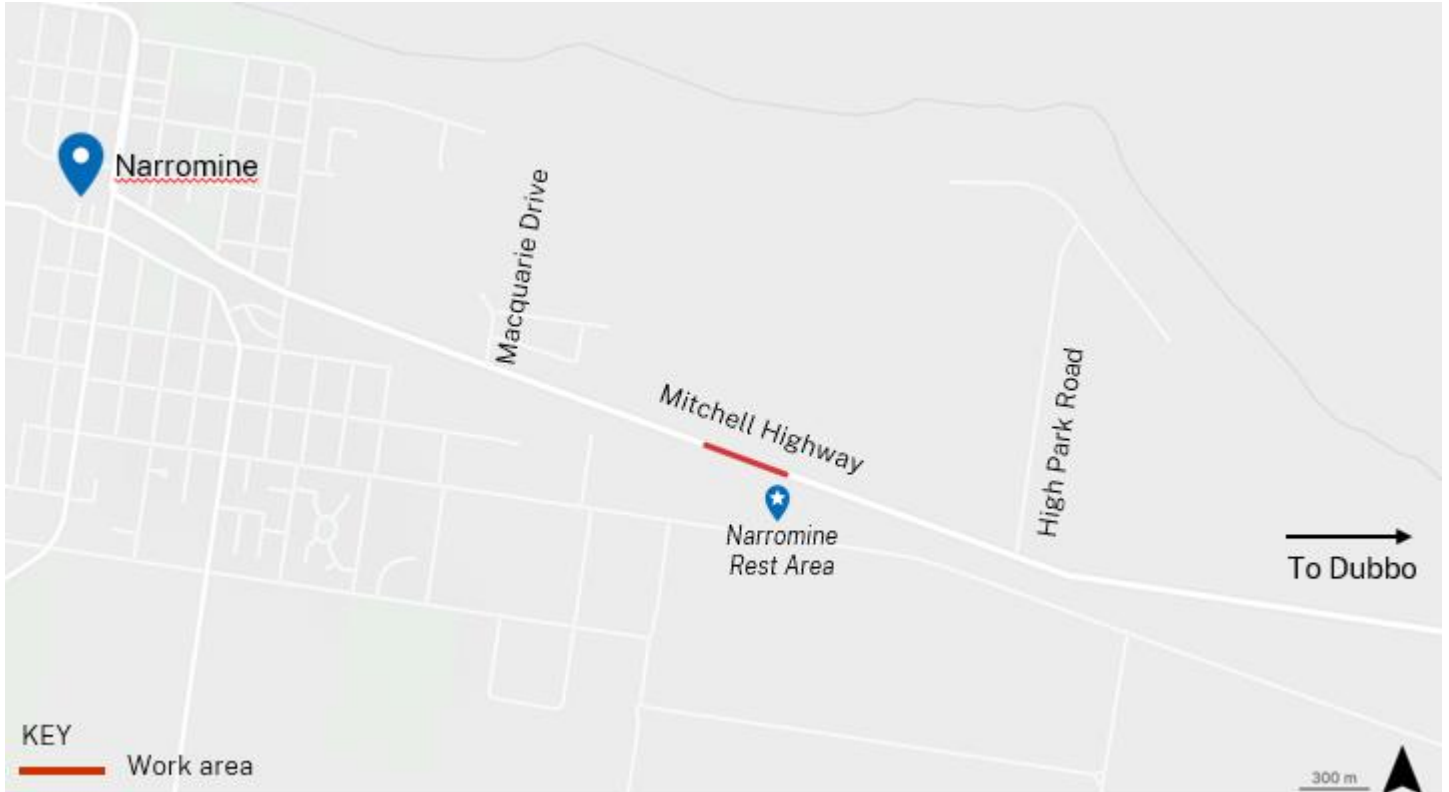
