From Tuesday 1 July to Thursday 31 July 2025

What we are doing

To improve traffic flow in the Westmead precinct, Sydney Trains will undertake construction works on the road-over-rail bridge at Bridge Road, Westmead from Tuesday 1 July to Thursday 31 July 2025.

Work activities include:

- Construction of deflection wall
- Installation of anti-throw screen
- Traffic railing installation.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise.
- **Work will take place from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and parking

- A contraflow may be in place on Bridge Road, between Alexandra Avenue and Byrne Street, on weekdays. Traffic flow will be maintained in both directions.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians during affected periods.
- Motorists are encouraged to plan their trip and use alternative routes to avoid the area. Please use trip planner to plan your journey.
