



Westmead Bridge Road Upgrade

July and August Update

From Monday 28 July to Sunday 31 August 2025

What we are doing

To improve traffic flow in the Westmead precinct, Sydney Trains will undertake construction works on the road-over-rail bridge at Bridge Road, Westmead from Monday 28 July to Sunday 31 August 2025.

Work activities include:

- Utilities relocation
- Installation of anti-throw screen
- Traffic railing installation

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- **Works will take place from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.

- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and parking

- **A contraflow may be in place on Bridge Road, between Alexandra Avenue and Byrne Street, on weekdays. Traffic flow will be maintained in both directions.**
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians during affected periods.

Temporary bus stop closures

- **From 4am Monday 28 July 2025 to 11pm Tuesday 31 August 2027, the bus stops on Bridge Road at Wentworth Avenue (Bus stop #2145542 and Bus stop #2145548) will be temporarily closed.** Please use the alternative bus stops on Bridge Road opposite Seventh Day Adventist Church.
