Arncliffe to Tempe Signalling Upgrade

August 2025

The Rail Service Improvement Program enables a safer, more equitable, and integrated transport network where people can travel more safely, reliably, and efficiently across NSW.

In August, we will be working within the rail corridor between Arncliffe and Tempe to continue upgrading signalling and rail infrastructure. In addition to these work areas, we will also be working within the rail corridor between Rockdale and Sydenham to complete track measurements for future testing and commissioning.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Installing, inspecting, and certifying signalling equipment
- Wiring and installation of cables
- Installing signalling infrastructure, including signals, train stops, track circuits, and automatic train protection equipment
- Pre-testing and wiring works for upcoming commissioning
- General construction activities including site set ups, inspections, and site surveys.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place within the rail corridor between Arncliffe and Tempe including through the Wolli Creek area. Our site compounds are located adjacent to the rail corridor between Arncliffe and Tempe, which will be used for

deliveries, storage of materials and equipment, worker briefings, and parking.

Standard construction hours on this project are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Out of hours work

Due to safety reasons, some preparatory work is required to take place during Sydney Trains maintenance windows within the rail corridor between Rockdale and Sydenham. This will take place between **6pm Monday 4 August and 6am Friday 8 August.**

Some additional work is also required to take place outside of standard construction hours. This work will take place between:

- **12am Tuesday 5 August and 6am Thursday 7 August**
- **6pm Friday 15 August and 6am Monday 18 August.**

Please note other agencies may be completing work in your area which is unrelated to our project.


What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- An increase in workers and construction vehicles, including near our former Lusty Street compound
- Increased noise from machinery and equipment
- Some temporary parking removal at our site access points.
