Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is installing 700 metres of koala exclusion fencing on both sides of Appin Road.

We notified for this work in June, however due to wet weather, work will continue until **Monday 25 August**.

What work are we doing?

We will be completing vegetation clearing and installation of temporary koala exclusion fencing

on both sides of Appin Road, between 612 and 715 Appin Road.

Our work will include:

- clear vegetation along both sides of Appin Road where necessary. Where possible, trees will be repurposed by local Aboriginal groups and the Department of Planning, Housing, and Infrastructure for future uses.
- install a temporary koala exclusion fence.



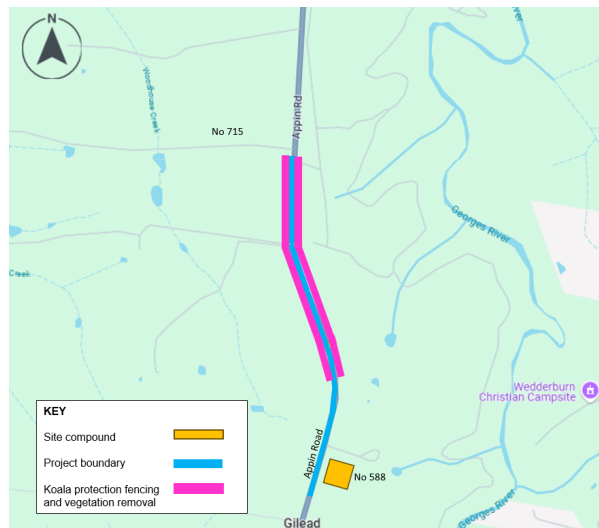
Our work may be noisy at times, but we will take care to reduce the noise as much as possible.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working between **8pm** and **5am** for up to **10 night shifts** from **Sunday 10 August to Monday 25 August**, weather permitting.

We do not work Friday, Saturday or public holidays.
