



Bardwell Park Station Upgrade Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

July 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Bardwell Park Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

What work are we doing?

In July construction activities will include:

- Concrete foundation work on the station platform
- Trenching and installation of services
- Installation of platform screening
- Establishment of the temporary site compound within Girrahween Park
- Completing other minor construction activities including, survey work, site inspections and investigations.

When we'll be working

In July, standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

Out-of-hours work

From **3am Saturday, 26 July to 11.59pm Sunday, 27 July**, construction will occur on and around the station platforms during a scheduled trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

Some of this work may be noisy at times, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses.

This work will require a **single-lane road closure on**

Hartill-Law Avenue between Slade Road and the entrance to the Earlwood Bardwell Park RSL Club during these times.

Please allow extra time for travel.

Temporary changes to parking within the RSL car park this month

From **Monday 21 July to Monday 28 July**, 15 parking spaces at the western end of the car park will be unavailable. These spaces will be used to house construction materials and waste bins.

From **3am Saturday, 26 July and 11.59pm Sunday, 27 July**, 85 car parking spaces, including the eight disabled parking spaces, along the boundary of the car park closest to the station will be unavailable.

To mitigate parking impacts, **six temporary disability car parking spaces** will be allocated within the RSL car park over the weekend of **Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 May**. These spaces will be clearly marked with signage.

Vehicle access to the RSL car park and pedestrian access across the bridge will remain open with traffic management in place.

Temporary reduction in speed limit on Hartill-Law Avenue

To improve the safety of pedestrians, motorists and construction workers during the station upgrade, a temporary speed limit of 40km/h has been introduced to all vehicles travelling along Hartill-Law Avenue until late 2026.



Signage along Hartill-Law Avenue is in place to inform motorists of the new speed limit. Please take care as speed limits are enforceable.

Impacts to War Memorial garden

To enable construction activities to take place safely and to minimise impacts to the local community, a crane will be positioned within the lower portion of the RSL War Memorial garden on **Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 July**.

Project site compound

A temporary site compound is to be set up within Girraheen Park on the eastern side of Hartill-Law Avenue, opposite the intersection with Bray Road.

National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) support the use of the site compound following completion of a Conservation Risk Assessment.

Strict environmental controls will be in place to protect the site, especially Wolli Creek itself.
