



Bardwell Park Station Upgrade Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

October 2025

Transport for NSW is upgrading Bardwell Park Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

What work are we doing this month?

In October, construction activities will include:

- Ongoing construction of the concrete lift shaft, stair support columns and platform
- Installation of steel for the new lift, platform posts, screens and canopies
- Installation of in-ground power and water service routes
- Surface regrading on the western end of the platform.

The majority of this work will take place behind the temporary screening on the station platform.

When we'll be working

In October standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

Out-of-hours work

From **9pm to 4am on Monday 13 and Tuesday 14 October**, work will take place on the station platform to remove scaffolding and waste materials. This activity has been scheduled at

night when trains are not running to reduce the impact on passengers and improve safety for workers.

Weekend work

From **3am Saturday 18 October to 11.59pm Sunday 19 October**, construction will occur on and around the station platforms during a scheduled trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

Some of this work may be noisy at times, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses.

This work will require a **single-lane road closure on Hartill-Law Avenue** between Slade Road and the entrance to the Earlwood Bardwell Park RSL Club over the weekend.

Please allow extra time for travel.

Additional weekend work teams

Sydney Trains will also be undertaking essential maintenance work during the scheduled trackwork weekend. Work activities include track resurfacing, tamping, and rail grinding, and is expected to be noisy. For more information please visit:

Temporary changes to parking within the RSL

From **3am Saturday 18 October to 11.59pm Sunday, 19 October**, 85 car parking spaces, including the eight accessible parking spaces, along the boundary of the car park closest to the station will be unavailable.

To mitigate parking impacts, **six temporary accessible car parking spaces** will be allocated within the RSL car park over the weekend of **Saturday 18 to Sunday 19 October**. These spaces will be clearly marked with signage.

Vehicle access to the RSL car park and pedestrian access across the bridge will remain open with traffic management in place.

40 km/h signage has been installed along Hartill-Law Avenue to inform motorists of the new temporary speed limit. Please take care as speed limits are enforceable.

Temporary changes to station toilets

From **Friday 17 October 2025**, the male toilets on the station platform will be closed until mid-2026. During this time, one of the female toilets will be converted to a unisex toilet for passenger use, while the other female toilet will be closed to customers. We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding while we work to construct new and improved toilet facilities on the station platform.
