

Bridge maintenance at Boree Creek on Peabody Road from Monday 7 July

June 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out essential maintenance work at the bridge over Boree Creek located around 15 kilometres south of Molong on Peabody Road to improve safety.

What work are we doing?

The work will include repairing the safety rails on the bridge to improve safety for all road users.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working at the bridge over Boree Creek on Peabody Road, around 800 metres north of the intersection with The Escort Way. We have provided a map over the page to show the location of the work.

Work will commence from **Monday 7 July 2025** and is expected to take up to **two weeks** to complete, weather permitting.

Working hours will be between **7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday**.

All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

We understand that the work will generate some inconvenience, and we thank you for your patience.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure a safe work zone, including:

- **intermittent stopping**
- **single lane closures**
- **a reduced speed limit of 40km/h** during work hours.

Outside of work hours, the speed limit will return to the posted speed of 100km/hr.

Please allow up to **ten minutes** of extra travel time during the work and always follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
