

Upcoming work on Bridge Road

Bridge Road Cycleway, Glebe

August 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal, Wangal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Work is progressing well on the Bridge Road upgrade and construction will continue through August.

To date we have finished two-thirds of trench restoration, with the section between Ross Street and Glebe Point Road now complete. The extended working hours and increased access over the weekends has helped our construction teams complete their work more efficiently.

As part of ongoing improvements, the pedestrian crossing at Woolley Street has been repainted, enhancing visibility and safety until the permanent improvements are made.

In the final phase of the project, the Woolley Street pedestrian crossing will be upgraded to a raised crossing, along with the crossing at the Cross Street intersection, making crossing the road safer. The road will also be completely resurfaced.

Weekend work from 9 August

From **Saturday 9 to Monday 11 August**, we'll be carrying out trench restoration along Bridge Road from Bellevue Street to Darling Street. We'll also continue trench restoration work into Darling Street and Railway Street.

From **Saturday 16 to Monday 18 August**, we'll continue the trench restoration on Bridge Road from Glebe Point Road to Railway Street. Further work will be carried out on Bridge Road from Glebe Point Road to Railway Street from **Saturday 23 to Monday 25 August**.

Noisier work will be completed before midnight.

Upcoming night work

Trench restoration work on Bridge Road between Lyons Road and Ross Street is scheduled for three nights between **Sunday 24 August to Friday 29 August**. Our working hours are from **8pm to 5am**.

There may also be some further maintenance work required along Bridge Road this month and we'll ensure the community is notified in advance.

What will this mean for you?

We'll be using excavators, saw cutters, profilers (to remove the road surface), compaction equipment and concrete and tipper trucks to carry out our work. You'll also notice:

- Temporary traffic changes, road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Detours with traffic controllers on site to guide people using the footpath and sections of the cycleway
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand that night work can cause disruption, particularly due to noise, light, and vibration from construction machinery. To help reduce these impacts, we're putting several noise mitigation measures in place, including:

- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Installing noise-reducing blankets and shade cloths around work areas.

We'll also use quieter equipment and fit machines with noise suppression tools, such as:

- Exhaust mufflers to reduce engine noise



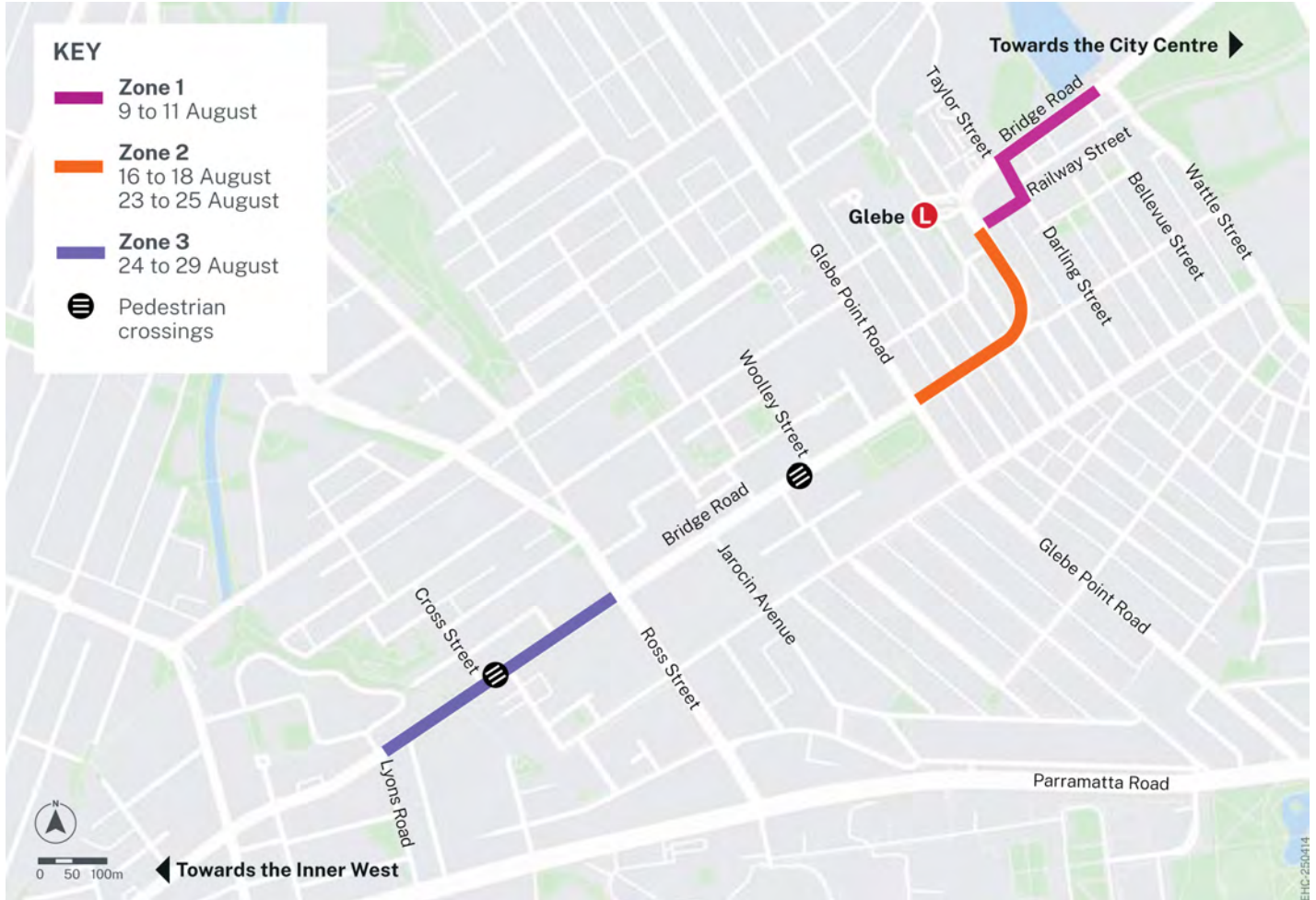
- Low noise reversing alarms instead of traditional beepers.
