

Upcoming work on Bridge Road

Bridge Road Cycleway, Glebe

September 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal, Wangal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is continuing work to deliver a range of improvements to Bridge Road, including an upgraded cycleway, two raised pedestrian crossings and a resurfaced road.

What work are we doing?

Trench restoration work has been impacted by heavy rain and is now expected to be completed by late September. This month we will also start work to resurface the road, including milling and resheeting, which will create a smoother, safer road surface.

Work includes:

- Resurfacing Bridge Road
- Construction of new ramps to provide access between the cycleway and the footpath
- Footpath restoration and improvement
- Temporary line marking.

Upcoming night work

From **Sunday 7 September to Tuesday 30 September**, we'll be working on Bridge Road between Lyons Road and Burton Street, as well as Railway Street. We'll also be working on Lyons Road between Parramatta Road and Bridge Road.

We'll complete work for up to three nights per week in one location to minimise impacts to the community.

Our working hours are from **8pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday**. Noisy and high impact work will be carried out before midnight.

Property access will continue to be maintained at all times.

Weekend work from 6 September

- From **Saturday 6 to Monday 8 September**, we'll be completing trench restoration along Bridge Road from Brougham Lane to Bellevue Street. Trenching will continue into Railway Street and Darling Street. Working hours are from **6am Saturday to 5am Monday**.
- From **Saturday 13 to Monday 15 September** and from **Saturday 20 to Monday 22 September**, we'll begin to mill and resheet Bridge Road from Glebe Point Road to Railway Street.
- From **Saturday 27 to Monday 29 September**, we'll mill and resheet Bridge Road from Ross Street to Glebe Point Road.

Weekend working hours from **Saturday 13 of September** will be from **8pm Saturday to 5am Monday**. Some noisy work may take place after midnight.

What will this mean for you?

The work will be noisy at times. We'll be using excavators, jack hammers, saw cutters and machines to remove the road surface, as well as



compaction equipment and concrete and tipper trucks.

You'll also notice:

- Temporary traffic changes, road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Detours with traffic controllers on site to guide people using sections of the footpath and cycleway.

Please observe traffic change information and traffic control directions.

Managing our impacts

We understand that night work can cause disruption, particularly due to noise, light, and vibration from construction machinery. To help reduce these impacts, we're putting several noise mitigation measures in place, including:

- Turning off machinery when not in use

- Installing noise-reducing blankets and shade cloths around work areas
- Pointing lights away from residential buildings where possible
- Using quieter equipment
- Fitting machines with noise suppression mufflers to reduce engine noise.

Location of night work

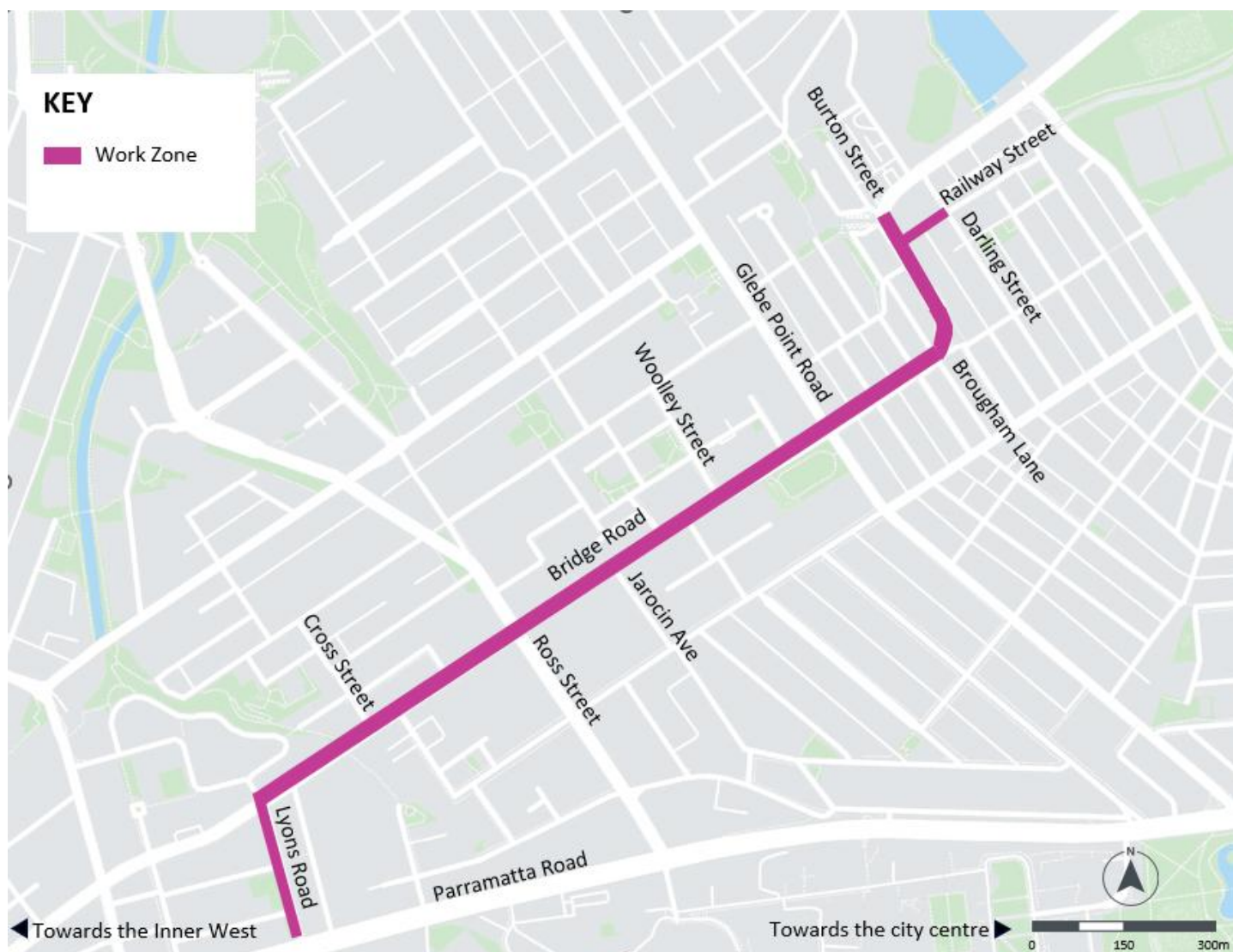




Image of a construction worker holding a traffic control sign.
