

Traffic improvements on Bunnerong Road, Pagewood

March 2025

Transport for NSW is improving safety and efficiency on Bunnerong Road in Pagewood.

We would like to thank everyone who provided feedback on the proposed changes to the Bunnerong Road and Birdwood Avenue intersection.

The majority of respondents supported the removal of right hand turns in and out of Birdwood Avenue.

The proposed changes included:

- removing right turns from Birdwood Avenue into Bunnerong Road
- removing right turns from Bunnerong Road into Birdwood Avenue
- widening the pedestrian refuge on Birdwood Avenue for safer crossing
- creating two new No Stopping zones along the northbound side of Bunnerong Road from 6am to 7pm, Monday to Friday (before the bus zone south of Birdwood Avenue and just north of Birdwood Avenue).

Changes to the proposal

Following community feedback, we reviewed the proposal and determined that improved access to the bus stop south of Birdwood Avenue could be achieved with a No Stopping zone that impacts only one parking space.

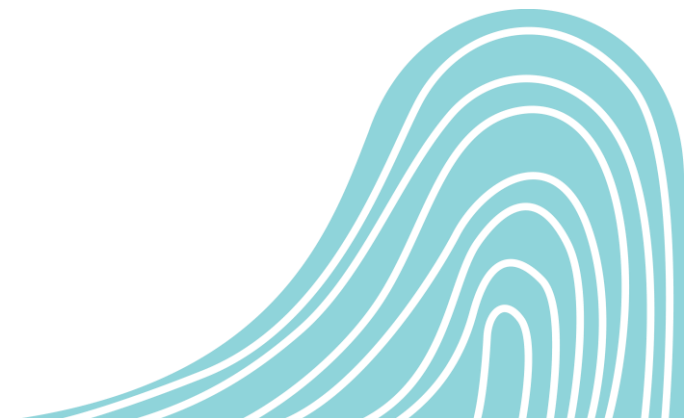
In the original proposal two parking spaces were affected.

Next steps

We expect to start work in mid-2025. Work is expected to take up to two months to complete, weather permitting.

We will update the community again before construction starts.



Amendments to the proposal after community feedback



Project benefits

Changing access into and out of Birdwood Avenue will improve safety for people walking and road users by reducing lane changing and weaving. It will also reduce the risk of collisions caused by right turns.

New No Stopping zones will:

- improve bus access to the bus stop to the south of Birdwood Avenue.
- improve traffic flow and provide more reliable travel times along Bunnerong Road by allowing vehicles to use all existing lanes for travel. This would reduce vehicle queueing at Botany Street behind right turning vehicles

How will these changes affect you?

Drivers will no longer be able to turn right into or out of Birdwood Avenue. Instead, they could use Prince Edward Circuit, located 150 metres north, which offers better visibility of oncoming traffic. The introduction of the No Stopping zone in the northbound lane will require:

- the removal of one car parking space, before the bus zone south of Birdwood Avenue
- the removal of 12 car parking spaces just north of Birdwood Avenue.

These No Stopping zones will only apply between 6am and 7pm, Monday to Friday.
