

Pedestrian safety improvements on Moore Street, Liverpool from Monday 5 May 2025

Bus Priority Infrastructure Program

The NSW Government is committed to restoring reliability across the public transport network.

The Bus Priority Infrastructure Program is a rolling program that delivers infrastructure to address the reliability and efficiency of bus services in Greater Sydney.

This work will improve your customer experience by upgrading pedestrian access to and from the existing bus stop, while also increasing safety.

Where and what work are we doing?

We will be working on Moore Street between Collimore Avenue and Beale Street, Liverpool to provide safer access to the bus stop.

Our work includes:

- providing a footpath to the bus stop
- relocating the bus stop sign
- new paved waiting area for passengers to board and exit buses safely
- installation of a new pedestrian refuge, kerb build outs and new line markings.

What is a pedestrian refuge?

A pedestrian refuge offers a waiting area between travel lanes for pedestrians, allowing them to cross one direction of traffic at a time. This improves safety and makes crossing easier.

When we'll be working

We will be onsite for up to **10-night shifts** between **Monday 5 May and Thursday 29 May 2025**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be between **8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday**.

We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights.

Managing our impacts

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and road users.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- completing noisy work activities by midnight where possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

What this means for you

The bus stop used by bus routes 804, 805, 806, 807, 827, 853 and 854 located near the work area on Moore Street, Liverpool will not be in operation during our work hours.

Please use the alternate bus stop on Moore Street near El Alamein Avenue about 370 m west of the current bus stop. See map over the page.

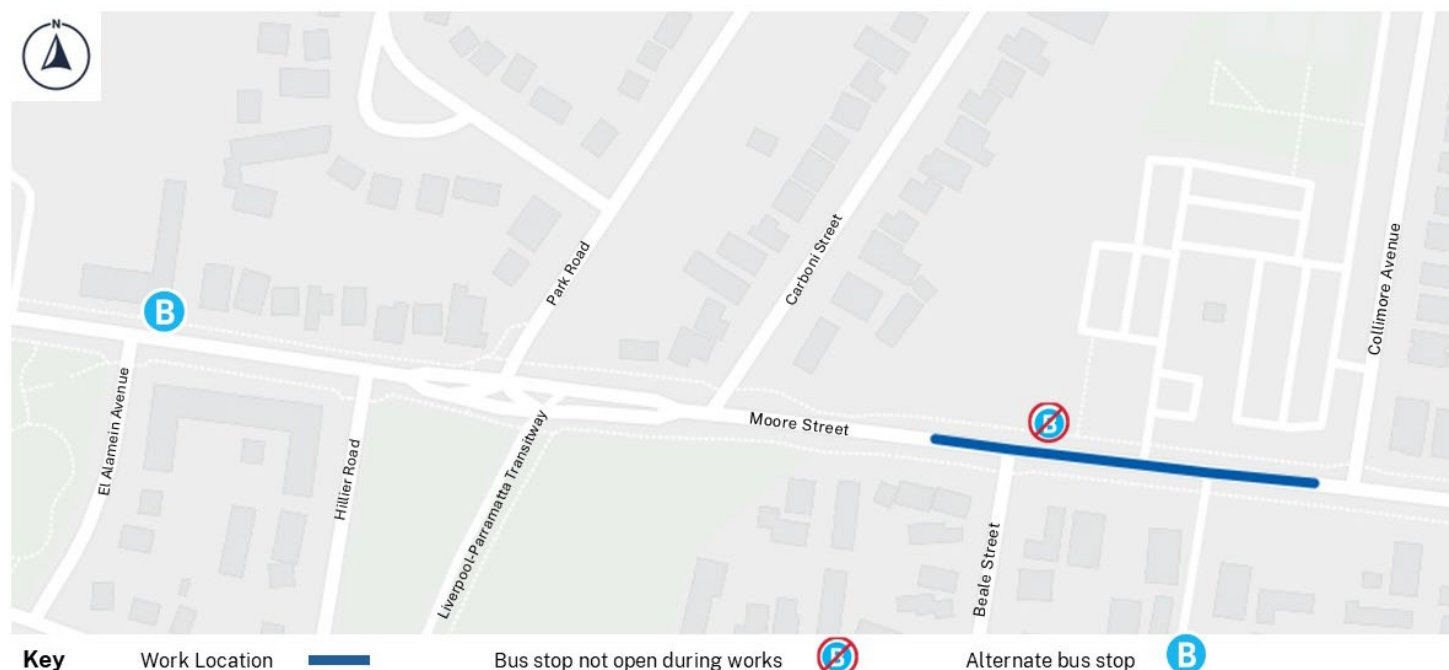


Traffic and pedestrian impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes while we complete this work. This includes a single lane closure and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic control and signs. Traffic control will assist road users and pedestrians through the work area if required.
