The NSW Government is committed to restoring reliability across the public transport network. The Bus Priority Infrastructure Program is a rolling program that delivers infrastructure to address the reliability and efficiency of bus services in Greater Sydney.

This work will improve the end-to-end customer experience by improving pedestrian access to and from existing bus stops as well as improving safety.

Where and what work are we doing?

We will be working at three locations on Pitt Town Road, McGraths Hill to provide a safer and more -accessible location for buses to stop and provide better accessibility for passengers.

Our work includes:

- relocating the bus stop on Pitt Town Road from the west side of Charles Street to the east side.
- providing footpaths to the bus stops
- widening the road shoulder to allow buses to pull up safely
- road resurfacing
- removing and relocating bus stop sign
- new paved waiting area for passengers to board and exit buses safely
- new line marking.

When and where we'll be working

We will be onsite for up to **7-night shifts** between **Tuesday 13 May and Tuesday 27 May 2025**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be between **8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday**.

We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights, or public holidays.

Managing our impacts

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and road users.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- completing noisy work activities by midnight where possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

What this means for you?

The bus stop 2756515 at the junction of Pitt Town Road and Wolseley Road will not be in operation during our working hours. This stop is used by bus route 672.

Please use the alternate bus stop 2756221 on Pitt Town Road, approximately 350m south-west of the current bus stop near Garfield Street. See map over the page.

While this work takes place, you may also notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage.




Traffic and pedestrian impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes while we complete this work. This includes lanes closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic control and signs.
