



Commemorative tribute survey now open

Captains Flat Former Station Master's Cottage Historical Interpretation Project March 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Have your say and complete the survey to help us best understand how to capture the history and values of the Captains Flat former Station Master's Cottage and identify a possible commemorative tribute.

The former Station Master's Cottage (Site) in Captains Flat holds cultural and historical significance for the community and surrounds.

Transport for NSW (Transport) identified contamination at the Site resulting from historical rail operations and is currently planning to remediate the Site.

The remediation strategy for the Site is to demolish the cottage and consider a commemorative tribute which recognises its historical significance to the local community.

To help us identify a possible tribute option, we are undertaking a historical interpretation project.

As a part of this project, Transport is consulting with community and stakeholders to continue building our knowledge and understanding of the historical, cultural and community importance of the Site.

When does consultation open?

Consultation is open from **2 April 2025** until **14 May 2025**.

We want to understand the historical values, personal stories and aspirations for the Site, so that we can identify and prioritise options for an appropriate commemorative tribute.

The information from the survey will be collated and used to identify themes and trends which Transport will consider when planning our work.
