


Changed traffic conditions on the Mid Western Highway near Lyndhurst from Monday 3 February



January 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance works on the Mid Western Highway near Lyndhurst, approximately 38 kilometres north east of Cowra, to provide a stronger, longer lasting and safer road.

What work are we doing?

Will be carrying out maintenance work along a one-kilometre section of the Mid Western Highway, which includes granular heavy patching works.

Work includes:

- using heavy machinery along the road
- pavement rehabilitation
- restoring the site when our works are finished.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place in Lyndhurst between Terminus Street and Queen Street on the Mid Western Highway.

We have included a map to show the location of work.

Work is expected to take **one week** to complete and will commence on **Monday 3 February 2025**, weather permitting.

Working hours are between **7am and 5pm** from **Monday to Friday.**

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- noise from machinery and equipment
- traffic control and signage in place.

Traffic Impacts

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe including intermittent stopping.

For the safety of workers and motorists, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will remain in place both during and outside of work hours, until the work is completed.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.


This includes:
