



Chester Hill Station Upgrade Community Notification



Safe Accessible Transport program

Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Chester Hill Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

What work are we doing?

In July, construction activities will include:

- Concrete foundation work behind screening on the platform
- Subject to final approvals, a temporary site compound is to be established in Nugent Park South.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

Out- of-hours work

From **12am to 2am, Friday 4 July**, work including the movement of heavy machinery will take place on the station platform.

Pending final approvals, we will also be working from **11pm Wednesday 23 July to 5am Thursday 24 July, and then again 11pm Thursday 24 July to 5am Friday 25 July** to install scaffolding and undertake spoil removal.

This activity has been scheduled at night when trains are not running to reduce the impact to rail customers.

Chester Hill Road bus stop

For one day of work between **Monday 7 and Friday 11 July**, a concrete truck and line pump will occupy the bus stop on the western side of Chester Hill Road, outside the station entrance.

On the day of work, this bus stop will be closed. The closest bus stops are located about 80 metres south, in front of the Chester Hill library and knowledge centre, and to the north, on Waldron Road.

Signage will be in place to inform and guide passengers.

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Fencing the work areas for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use
- Using quieter equipment where possible
- Providing traffic controllers and signage to direct road users, passengers and pedestrians.

Temporary site compound

The site compound, to be established close to the rail corridor in Nugent Park South, will house site offices, storage and worker amenities and is designed to minimise disruption to the surrounding community.
