Chester Hill Station Upgrade Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

June 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Chester Hill Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

During May, work included:

- Foundation work for the new elevated concourse, stairs, platform canopy, lift shaft
- Closure of existing toilets and installation of a temporary unisex toilet on the platform
- Installation of plywood screening on the platform to provide a safe work area.

What work are we doing next?

In June, construction activities will take place on the station platform. This includes:

- Concrete foundation work behind the plywood screening at the city and country ends of the platform
- Installation of steel reinforcements underneath the existing entrance stairs and at the country end of the platform.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.

There is no planned work outside of standard construction hours in June. Should the need for any out-of-hours work arise, affected businesses and residents will be notified prior to the work starting.

Chester Hill Road bus stop

For one day of work between **Monday 9 and Friday 13 June**, a concrete truck and pump will occupy the bus stop on the western side of Chester Hill Road, outside the station entrance.

On the day of work, this bus stop will be closed. The closest bus stop is located about 80 metres south, in front of the Chester Hill library.

Signage will be in place to guide passengers.

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts to the community by:
Fencing the work areas for safety and security
Reducing our noise as much as possible by
turning off equipment when not in use
Using quieter equipment where possible
Providing traffic controllers and signage to direct
road users and pedestrians.

Train schedules will not be impacted by this project, and we will make every effort to minimise disruptions for HSC students during the exam period.





DID YOU KNOW.....

Boarding Assistance Zones on train station platforms are designed to support passengers who need extra help getting on or off the train, such as people using wheelchairs, mobility aids, prams, luggage or those with an injury.

These clearly marked areas are typically located near the guard's carriage to make it easier for staff to identify those requiring assistance.

Staff may deploy a **portable boarding ramp** to bridge the gap between the train and the platform to assist passengers to board the train safely and comfortably.

Boarding Assistance Zones are part of a broader commitment by Transport to create a safer and more accessible public transport system.
