Avoca Drive upgrade, Kincumber

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing \$130 million towards upgrades to Avoca Drive at Kincumber. The proposed upgrade will improve traffic flow and deliver infrastructure for active and public transport access on Avoca Drive through the township of Kincumber.

What work are we doing?

To help progress the concept design and identify environmental constraints along Avoca Drive and nearby streets, will be carrying out geotechnical investigations.

Work includes:

- establishing a temporary work site
- locating existing underground services
- digging using geotechnical machinery including drill rigs, support trucks and associated hand tools
- restoring the work area when our investigations are finished.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working along Avoca Drive and nearby streets including Willesee Crescent, Kincumber Street, Bungoona Road, Tilba Street, Gunya Road, Davies Street and Carrak Road from **Sunday 24 August to Friday 12 September**, weather permitting.

To limit disruption along the road network during peak hours, most of our work will be carried out at night between **7pm and 5am, Sunday to Thursday.**

At times, the investigation work will also need to be carried out during the day between **7am and 6pm**, **Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm on Saturday.**

What will this mean for you?

The work will be carried out in stages over the investigation period to minimise noise impacts to residents.

There will be some temporary changed traffic conditions in place along Avoca Drive and nearby local streets including at the roundabout connecting Avoca Drive, Carrak Road and Bungoona Road.

You may notice:

- workers, vehicles and movement of machinery and equipment
- traffic controllers and signage
- single lane closures and reduced speed limits which may impact travel times
- pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- noise and lights from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing our work areas for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill protecting trees with no-go areas
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.
