From Friday 24 October to Monday 27 October 2025

What we are doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains will complete embankment stabilisation works at Brooklyn from Friday 24 October to Monday 27 October.

Work activities include:

- vegetation and rock removal
- installation of rockfall protection system
- Helicopter for lifting the materials

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend.
- Work will take place from 6am to 7pm Saturday 25 October and Sunday 26 October.
- Site mobilisation and demobilisation will take place from 7am to 6pm Friday 24 October and Monday 27 October.
- Equipment required for the work includes chainsaw, chipper, jack hammers and compressors. We will select low-noise compressors and equipment, where low-noise alternatives are available
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and parking

- Heavy vehicles will use Brooklyn Road to access the rail corridor. Parking will be limited near access gates.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
