

Epping Bridge Project

Early work activities

September 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumedegal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW governments are investing \$220 million in funding to replace Epping Bridge with a new, wider bridge to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety for road users.

Early works will continue to be carried out within the road and rail corridors between **Monday 15 September** and **Friday 31 October 2025**.

Activities to be carried out include investigation works, installation of rail services, cable routes and cables and upgrades to drainage infrastructure.

The work will be carried out within the road and rail corridors between Brigg Road and Carlingford Road, Epping.

What work are we doing?

Work activities include:

- establishing temporary work sites
- survey investigations
- excavation work to complete cable installation and relocation within the rail corridor
- installation of rail services, cable routes and cables
- upgrades to drainage infrastructure within the rail corridor
- removal of spoil from site for testing
- restoring disturbed areas once work has been completed.

When and where we will be working

The work will be carried out during both day and night shifts between **Monday 15 September** and **Friday 31 October 2025**.

Our day work schedule will be between **Monday** and **Friday, 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday, 8am to 1pm**.

Our night work schedule will be between **Monday** and **Friday, 6pm to 7am** for up to **six nights** in **September** and **ten nights** in October.

We will not work more than two nights each week. We will not work on Sundays or on the Monday 6 October public holiday.

Additional out of hours work will also be carried out during planned Sydney Trains weekend trackwork, between **Friday 24 October, 6pm** and **Monday 27 October, 7am**.

What will this mean for you?

Some of the work may be noisy, however, we will make every effort to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and machinery when not in use
- assessing each work activity to manage any potential impacts to nearby residents and businesses
- fitting equipment with devices that assist in minimising noise, such as non-tonal reversing beepers on vehicles
- monitoring our noise levels.

Temporary traffic and parking changes

We will access the rail corridor via High Street and Beecroft Road.



You may notice some temporary traffic changes on both streets to make sure the work zone is safe. Traffic control and reduced speed limits may affect travel times.

Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as required.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

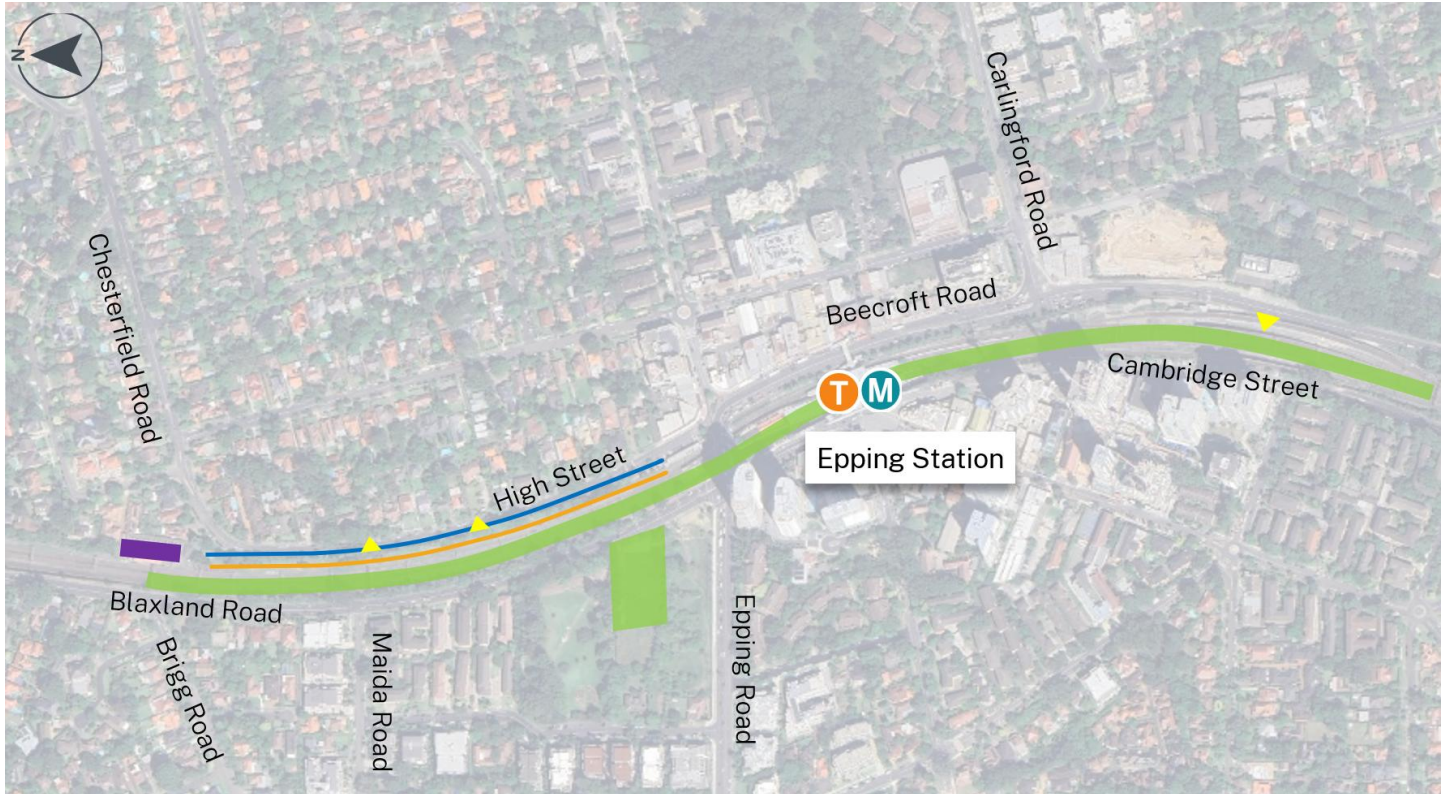
We may also need to temporarily use some parking spaces on High Street between **Friday 24 October, 6am** and **Monday 27 October, 6pm**.
