



Day and night work on Elizabeth Drive continues from 1 July 2025

Community notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is progressing the Elizabeth Drive upgrade to improve safety and support growth and connectivity around the Western Sydney Airport precinct.

Transport will continue site investigations, safety and maintenance work along Elizabeth Drive between Badgerys Creek Road and Duff Road. The investigations will further inform the design for the Elizabeth Drive upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Our work involves:

- land surveying
- digging and drilling holes to check ground conditions and utilities
- maintaining drainage
- collecting samples of soil for testing
- resurfacing the existing road between Clifton Avenue and Devonshire Road
- building concrete kerbs
- adding line markings.

We will use light vehicles, a track mounted drilling rig, vacuum truck, survey equipment, testing and scanning equipment, lighting towers and small hand tools to complete this work.

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place along the side of Elizabeth Drive between Badgerys Creek and Duff roads. We will be onsite from **1 July to 19 December 2025**, weather permitting.

The work on the road surface between Clifton Avenue and Devonshire Road at Kemps Creek will be up to five night shifts.

We may need to access some private properties. We will directly contact those property owners to arrange.

Our working hours will be from **8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**. We will not work on public holidays.

There will be occasions when we may need to carry out work activities during the night.

Our night shift hours would be between **8pm and 7am** from **Sunday to Thursday**.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes such as shoulder and lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the directions of traffic control and signs.



Managing our impacts

Our work may generate some low-level noise. We will do everything we can to minimise disruption, including:

- Switching off vehicles/machinery when not in use

- Reminding workers to minimise unnecessary noise
- Directing lighting towers away from properties when working at night.
