Bus Priority Infrastructure Program

The NSW Government is committed to restoring reliability across the public transport network. The Bus Priority Infrastructure Program is a rolling program that delivers infrastructure to address the reliability and efficiency of bus services in Greater Sydney.

This work will improve the end-to-end customer experience by improving pedestrian access to and from existing bus stops as well as improving safety.

Where and what work are we doing?

We will be working at two locations on Great Western Highway, near Dukes Oval and Warring Avenue, Emu Plains to provide a safer location for buses to stop and provide better access for passengers.

Our work includes:

- providing a footpath to the bus stop near Warring Avenue
- constructing a pram ramp at the bus stop near Warring Avenue
- widening the road shoulder and road resurfacing to allow buses to pull up safely
- relocating the bus stop sign
- new paved waiting area for passengers to board and exit buses safely
- new line marking.

When and where we'll be working

We will be onsite for up to **7-night shifts** at the two locations between **Wednesday 14 May and Thursday 29 May 2025**, weather permitting.

Our working hours will be between **8pm and 5am Sunday to Thursday**.

We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights.

Managing our impacts

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and road users.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- completing noisy work activities by midnight where possible
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

What this means for you?

The bus stops 2750258 and 2750378 at the junctions of Park Street and Warring Avenue will not be in operation during our working hours. Bus routes 688, 689, 690P and 691 use this bus stop.

Please use the alternate bus stops 2750259 on Great Western Highway, before Gardenia Avenue and opposite Nepean High School, about 350m north of the current bus stops. See map over the page.

While this work takes place, you may also notice:

- workers and vehicles



- traffic controllers and signage.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

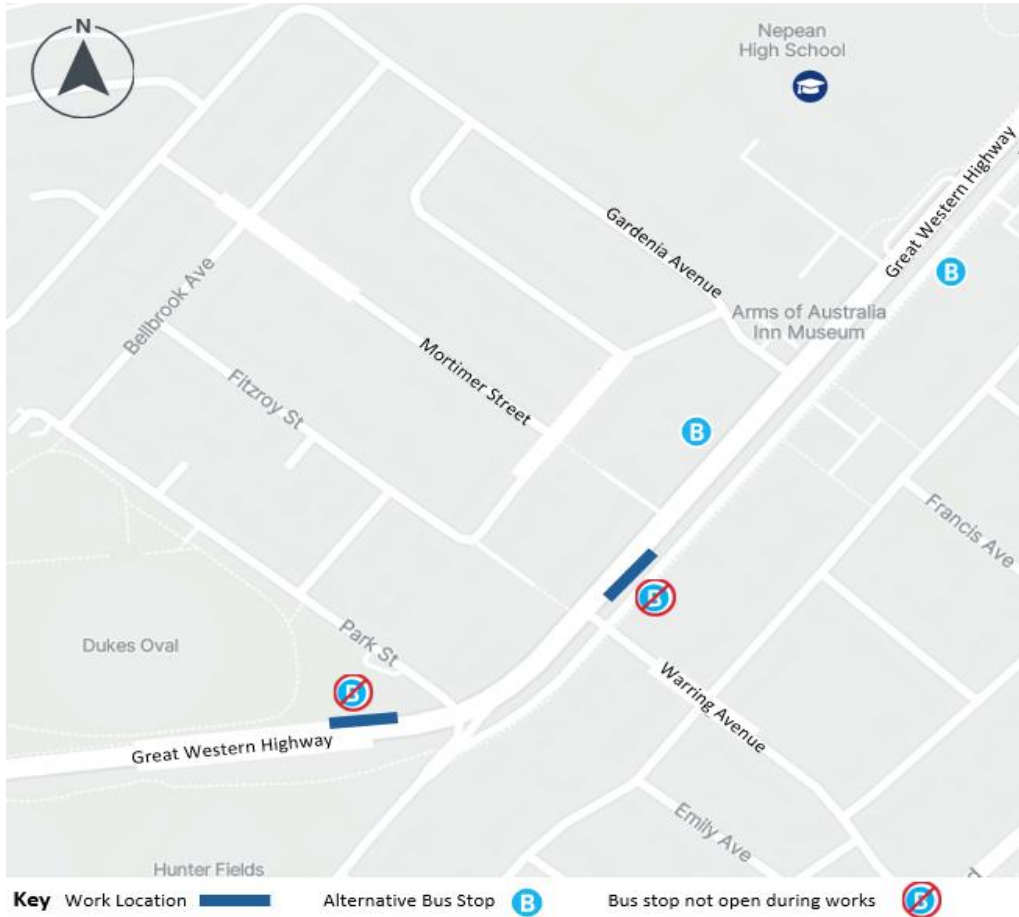
There will be temporary traffic changes while we complete this work. This includes lanes closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic control and signs.

Traffic control will assist road users and pedestrians through the work area if required.
