

Changed traffic conditions on Duckmaloi Road from Monday 27 October

Oberon Council is carrying out essential maintenance work on behalf of Transport for NSW on a section of Duckmaloi Road, near Oberon.

What work are we doing?

The maintenance work will include patching and resealing to improve road surfaces and provide safer journeys for all road users.

When and where we'll be working

Oberon Council will be working at various sections along Duckmaloi Road between the Albion Street and the Jenolan Caves Road intersections.

We have included a map over the page to show the location of work.

Works will be carried out between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday to Friday**.

Work will start on **Monday 27 October** and is expected to be completed in **six weeks**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if any work needs to occur outside of these hours.

Traffic impacts

For the safety of workers and motorists, a number of traffic changes will be in place:

- Reduced speed limits
- Intermittent stopping.

Due to the narrow alignment of the road, traffic may be held for up to **five minutes** to facilitate this important work.

Reduced speeds will also be in place outside normal work hours while works are underway.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.

Managing our impacts

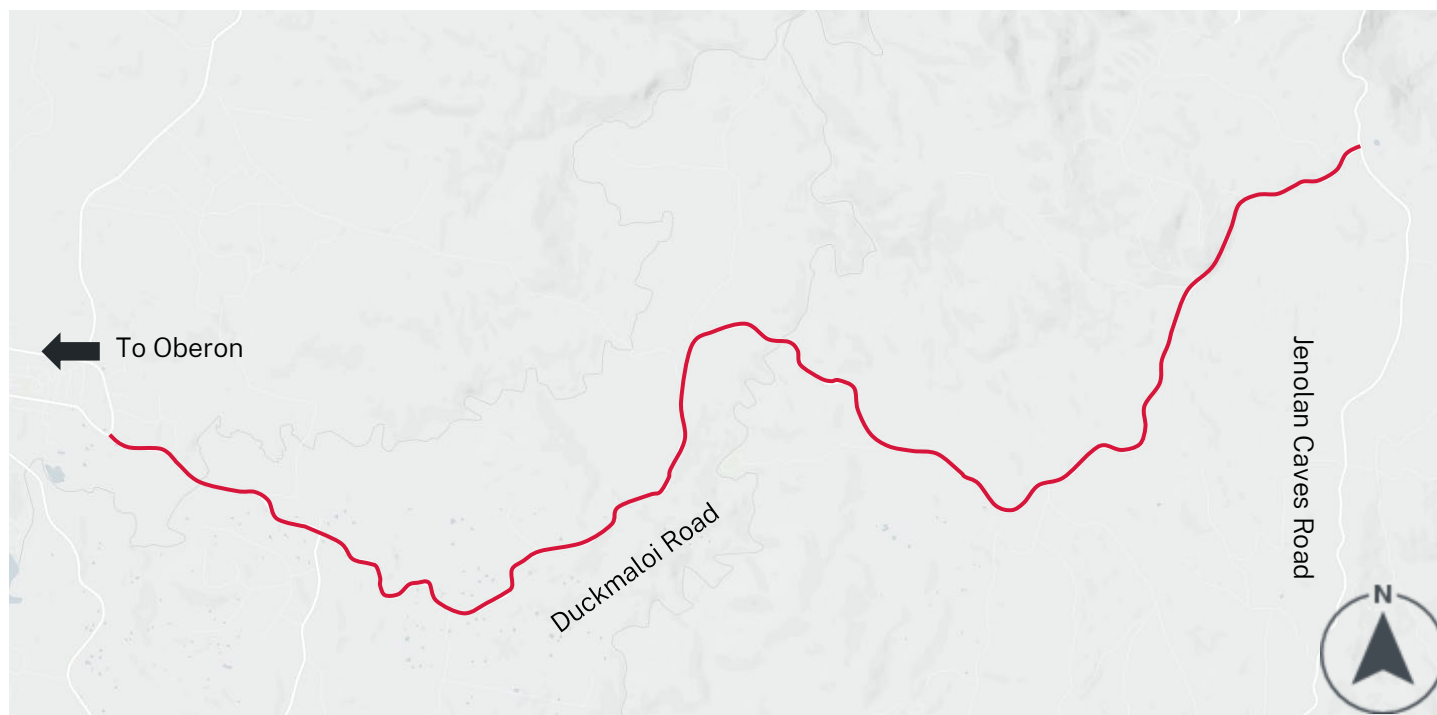
We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.
