

# Nightwork on Great Western Highway for Evans Bridge maintenance

September 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out routine bridge maintenance work on Evans Bridge on Great Western Highway, between Bathurst and Kelso.

## What work are we doing?

The work will include rehabilitation of steel expansion joints in the westbound lane of Evans Bridge.

## When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at **Evans Bridge near the intersection of Great Western Highway and Havannah Street** from **29 September, for four nights**, weather permitting.

We will be working at night from **7pm to 6am, Monday to Fridays**.

## Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe, including:

- a reduced speed limit of 40 km/hour in the westbound lane
- westbound lane closures (from two to one lane) through the work area.

Outside of work hours, both lanes will be open and revert to the posted speed limit.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside of these hours.

All road users are advised to follow the directions of signs and traffic control and slow down on approach.

## Managing our effects on the community

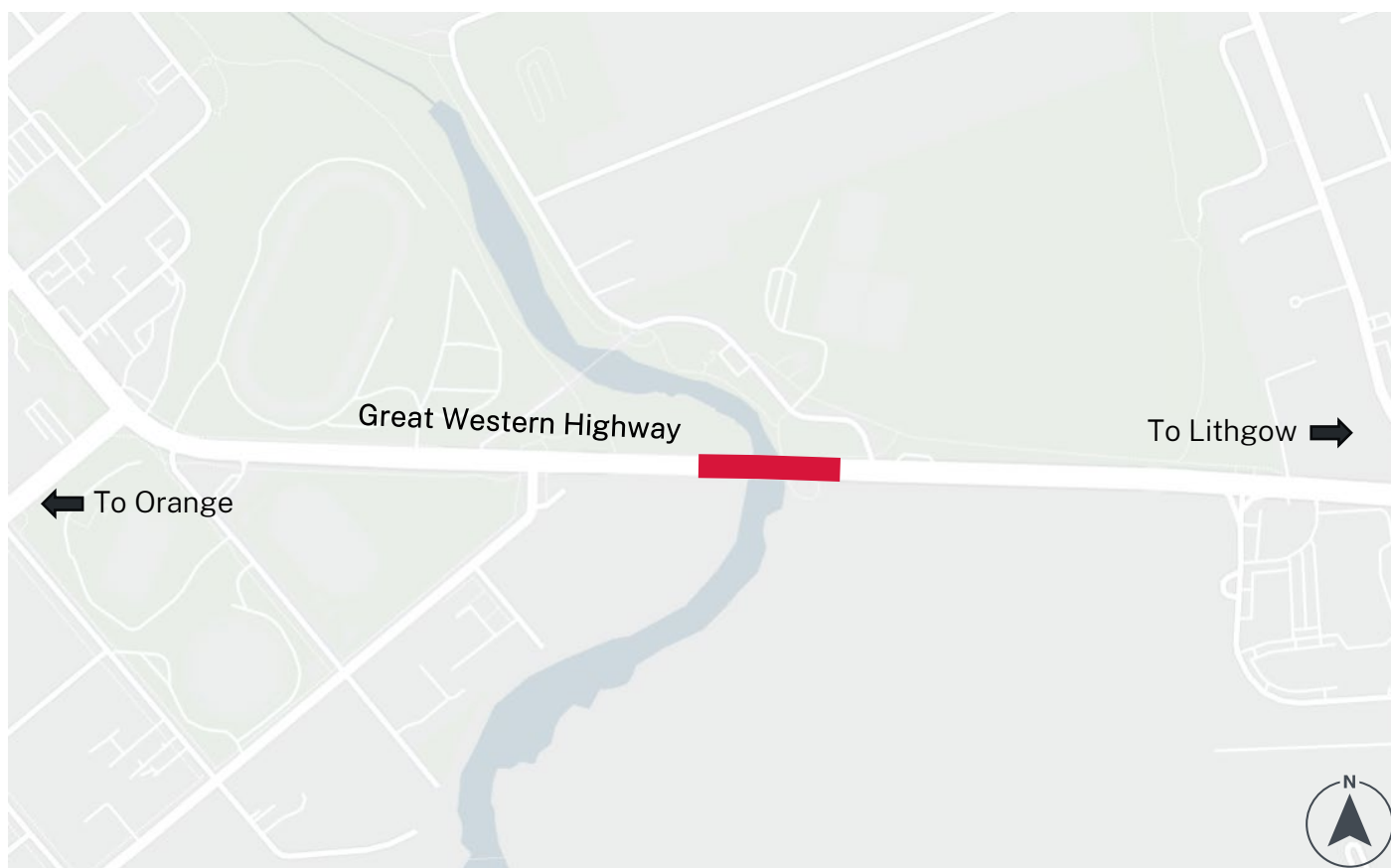
We aim to manage our work to minimise disruption to the community and the environment.
