

Continued night work and street parking impacts on Frenchmans Road, Randwick



Temporary tow away zones continue from 27 May, weather permitting



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is carrying out important road resurfacing work on Frenchmans Road, between Carrington Road and Avoca Street, Randwick.

Due to the recent wet weather, we were unable to complete our works within the initially anticipated timeframe and will need to return to site to carry out the remaining **eight shifts from Tuesday 27 May**, weather permitting.

Temporary tow away zones will continue to apply on Frenchmans Road from **Sunday to Thursday, between 6pm and 5am.** to allow us to deliver these works. Motorists and residents will be unable to park in designated sections of Frenchmans Road after 6pm.

- Vehicles parked in temporary tow away zones between 6pm and 5am will be towed from the work zone
- Tow away signage along Frenchmans Road will be updated to reflect exact dates and a contact number for support if required
- Frenchmans Road will remain open to traffic and pedestrians
- Traffic control and signage will provide advance notice.
