# **Speed limit reductions in Austral and Rossmore from Sunday 10 August 2025**

## **Community notification**

August 2025







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cabrogal people of the Dharug Nation Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands and waterways on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will make changes to the existing speed limits on Fifteenth Avenue, Western Road Devonshire Road and Ramsay Road, Austral and King Street, Rossmore from Sunday 10 August 2025.

These changes have taken into consideration traffic flow, the surrounding road environment, future development in the area and access to properties.

Road safety is a shared responsibility – everyone needs to make safe decisions on and around the road to prioritise safety.

Your speed decides the outcome. Speed increases the risk of having a crash, as well as the severity of the crash.

## What work are we doing

Work involves replacing existing speed limit signage and road markings to assist with the following speed limit changes.

- Fifteenth Avenue, from 160m west of Fourth Avenue to Ramsay Road – reduced from 80 km/h to 60 km/h
- Ramsay Road, between Fifteenth Avenue and Wynyard Avenue – reduced from 70 km/h to 60 km/h

- Western Road, between Elizabeth Drive and Fifteenth Avenue - reduced from 80 km/h to 60 km/h
- Devonshire Road, between Elizabeth Drive and King Street - reduced from 70 km/h to 60 km/h
- King Street, between Devonshire Road and Bringelly Road - reduced from 70 km/h to 60 km/h.

New speed limits will be enforceable from the date that signage is installed.

#### When will we be working?

We were expecting to complete this work in June; however, circumstances did not allow that.

We will be on site for up to two day shifts and one night shift between **Sunday 10 August and Sunday 31 August,** weather permitting.

Our day shift hours are between 8am and 3pm, and night shift hours are between 8pm and 5am. We will not work on Friday or Saturday nights.

#### Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:


- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- · completing noisier tasks by midnight.

### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place for the safety of road users and our workers. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
