Tree removal works at Bonds Road and Boundary Road

Forest, Bonds and Boundary Road Intersection Upgrade



September 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading the intersection at Forest Road, Bonds Road and Boundary Road to improve safety and traffic flow for all road users.

As part of this work, thirteen street trees along Bonds Road and Boundary Road will be removed to allow for road widening and safety improvements.

What work are we doing?

Work will include:

- Establishing a safe work zone with fencing
- Using chainsaws, machinery and elevated work platforms to safely remove trees
- Mulching and removing branches and trunks from site

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working along Bonds Road and Boundary Road near the Forest Road intersection from **Monday 15** to **Monday 22 September 2025.**

Working hours are **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday nights**, with **noisy activities completed before midnight** wherever possible. No work will take place on Friday or Saturday nights.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control and intermittent lane closures will be in place during work hours. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage in the area.

You may also notice noise from machinery such as chainsaws and woodchippers while the trees are being removed.

We understand this work may be disruptive at times and thank you for your patience.

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts on nearby residents and businesses. Our approach is designed to keep the community safe and reduce disruption wherever possible.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- Switching off machinery when not in use

These trees have been carefully assessed by qualified arborists and approved for removal through the project's environmental review.
