


# Garie Road landslip repairs now complete

## Project update

September 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Tharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

### Transport for NSW has completed important road repair work at Garie Road and the road is now open.

Severe wet weather experienced across Sydney in mid-2022 caused a major landslide on Garie Road, resulting in a full closure of the road. Ground movement continued throughout 2023/24 due to ongoing rainfall, preventing the commencement of repair work.

This repair work began in July 2024 and has resulted in a stronger road with greater resilience to future wet weather events.

Transport collaborated with National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) throughout the project to ensure other projects in the Royal National Park could be delivered.


We acknowledge the Garie Road closure has impacted access to the Garie Beach precinct and thank the community for their patience and understanding while we completed this important work.

### Garie Beach Surf Life Saving Club





