

Harley Hill Road level crossing upgrade

Transport for NSW is continuing upgrades at the rail level crossing on Harley Hill Road at Berry to improve safety for road and rail users and meet current Australian Safety Authority standards.

What work are we doing?

Over the coming weeks, we'll be finalising work to upgrade the level crossing. Work includes installing safety barriers, boom gates, lights, signage and line marking.

When we'll be working

We'll be working between **7am and 5pm**, from **Monday 8 to Wednesday 10 September 2025**, weather permitting.

Later in September, we'll be working both day and night over one weekend to finalise the upgrade, test and commission the new crossing. This work will be carried out from **6am Saturday 20 September to 10pm Sunday 21 September 2025**, weather permitting.

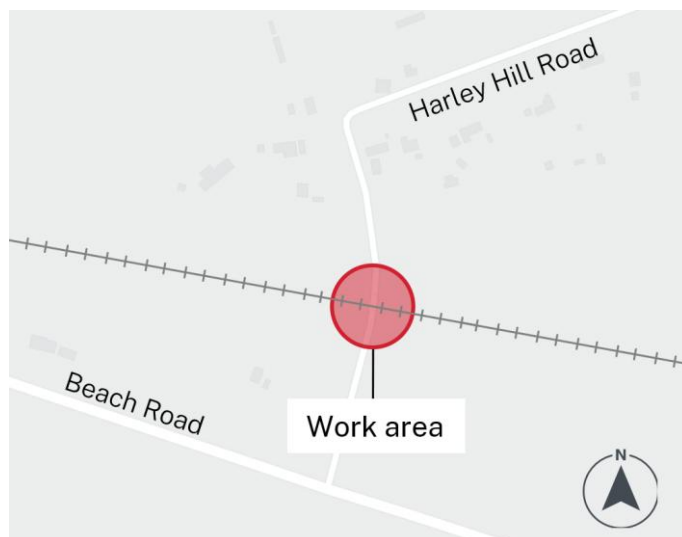
What will this mean for you?

During work hours, we'll be using machinery and equipment that generates noise, light and vibrations. Machinery and equipment will include handheld drills, generators, lighting towers and other light vehicles.

Traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place during work hours. Motorists are advised to following the directions of signs and traffic controllers.
