Safety improvement work at Epping Road, North Ryde from 12 June

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumedegal Clan of the Darug nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is improving road safety at Epping Road, North Ryde.

The Road Safety Program, which was launched in early 2024, aims to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads.

The Australian and NSW governments are investing \$518 million into road safety projects across NSW.

What work are we doing?

Work will include resurfacing the road with high friction asphalt on westbound lanes at **Epping** Road, between Delhi Road and Wicks Road, North Ryde.

This work will also extend into Wicks Road, between Epping Road and Marshall Place, North Ryde.

The work also includes repainting line markings. Please refer to map overleaf.

When will we be working?

We will be onsite for up to **five night shifts** between **Thursday 12 June and Thursday 7 August,** weather and site conditions permitting.

Our work hours will be from 8pm to 5am.

For the safety of road users, and to minimise traffic disruption, our work will take place at night.

We will not work Fridays, Saturdays or public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

Local road restrictions

At times during work hours, vehicle access into Wicks Road from Epping Road may be impacted and adjacent roads will need to be used to access Wicks Road.

Please follow the guidance of onsite traffic controllers and signage. Access to residents' properties will be maintained at all times.

Additional traffic changes

Other traffic changes will also be in place **between 8pm and 5am** and include:

- a work zone speed of 40 km/h
- lane closures
- minor local road detours
- onsite traffic controllers providing guidance
- variable messaging signs (VMS) providing advanced notice of traffic changes.

Managing our impacts

Equipment used will include a saw cutter and a jack hammer. We aim to reduce impacts to the community and environment as much as possible.

This includes:

- reducing noise and vibration
- turning off equipment when not in use
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- stopping work where possible for respite
- completing noisier tasks by midnight.
