

Night work on King Street

Construction on the King Street Cycleway is continuing between Clarence and York streets. As part of the first stage of work, we are carrying out survey investigations and drainage upgrades.

What work are we doing?

Upcoming work includes:

- Adjusting traffic lights
- · Stormwater drainage pit upgrades
- Kerb and footpath adjustments
- Locating existing underground services
- Using machinery to cut into the road and footpath


When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on **King Street** between **Clarence Street** and **York Street** until **22 May 2025.** Working hours are **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.** Noisy activities, such as saw cutting, will be completed by **midnight.**

To minimise impacts during the Vivid Sydney events from **23 May to 14 June**, only low impact work and service investigations will take place between Clarence and York Streets.
