



# Utility investigations on King Street between George Street and Pitt Street

## King Street Cycleway

July 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out utility investigations for the King Street Cycleway project.

These investigations will help us plan the relocation of underground gas services and is an important step to prepare the area for the new cycleway.

To reduce disruption, we'll do this work over a weekend and restore the road at the end of each day shift so lanes can reopen to traffic at night.

### What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- establishing a temporary work site
- locating existing underground services
- using saw cutting tools, jackhammers and vacuum trucks to excavate
- reinstating the road surface with asphalt at the end of each shift.

### When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on **King Street between George Street and Pitt Street on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 July**. Our work hours will be between **7am and 5pm** weather permitting.

Please note that work hours and activities may change due to weather conditions or unforeseen site circumstances. We will renotify if there are changes.

### What will this mean for you?

Here's what you may notice during the weekend:

- Increased activity in the area, including workers, machinery, and traffic control staff
- Construction noise, particularly in the morning, as we carry out road cutting and excavation.
- There may be traffic delays when travelling on King Street with reduced lanes. Please allow additional travel time
- Businesses will remain accessible throughout the work

### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. During work, road users, residents and businesses may experience temporary changes, including:


- fencing around the work area for the safety and security of our workers and the public
- noise from the excavation. The use of noise curtains will be used to minimise noise where possible.

Two lanes will be closed **between 7 am and 5 pm on both days** and traffic controllers will be on site managing traffic.

Access to driveways will be maintained at all times. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers.
