



Safety upgrades on Kosciuszko Road east of Jindabyne

October 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out safety upgrades to the Kosciuszko Road intersections with Geikle Creek Road and Bushy Park Road.

What work are we doing?

We'll be carrying out safety upgrades at the intersections as part of the Towards Zero Safer Roads program.

Work includes:

- constructing right-turn lanes at both intersections
- realigning the intersection at Geikle Creek Road
- resurfacing Kosciuszko Road and sealing intersections of Geikle Creek Road and Bushy Park Road
- widening shoulders on Kosciuszko Road
- installing safety barriers, new signage and line marking.

To construct a right-turn lane into Bushy Park Road, the eastbound overtaking lane on Kosciuszko Road will be shortened by around 300 metres. The length of the overtaking lane will be around 2 km once work is complete.

Additionally, some vegetation management within the road corridor will be required to widen shoulders and remove roadside hazards.

When we'll be working

We'll be working weekdays between **7am and 6pm**, from **Monday 27 October 2025 for up to six months**, weather permitting. Some work on Saturdays may be required at times. On these occasions, our working hours will be 8am to 1pm.

Work will not be carried out over the Christmas holiday period and residents will be advised of the closedown dates in advance.

What will this mean for you?

During work, traffic control and single lane closure will be in place on Kosciuszko Road.

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- temporary site compound
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and stop/slow traffic control
- reduced speed limits of 40 km/h.

Changes to Geikle Creek Road access

During the later stages of work, from February 2026, the southern end of Geikle Creek Road will be closed while we realign the intersection and seal approximately 125 metres of Geikle Creek Road.

Residents will be detoured via the northern end of the local road, adding up to approximately six minutes travel time.

Bushy Park Road access will be maintained throughout work however there may be delays of up to a few minutes during some stages of work.

Changes to informal bus stops

Buses that use Geikle Creek Road and Bushy Park as informal bus stops will continue to do so during work.

As work progresses near each of the intersections, the stopping locations may change slightly.

We will aim to maintain the existing locations as much as possible while ensuring the safety of the community during this time.
