## Princes Highway upgrade program

### Night work update – Temporary traffic changes

February 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

During March, work continues on the Jervis Bay Road intersection upgrade. For the safety of the community and workers, and to minimise disruption to traffic, some work will be carried out at night and requires detours.

#### What work are we doing?

We will be carrying out work to install new drainage, road surfaces and line marking on a section of Jervis Bay Road. Safety barriers may also be installed/relocated during these shifts.

#### When we'll be working

Work will be carried out over four nights on:

- **Wednesday 5 and Thursday 6 March 2025**
- **Wednesday 12 and Thursday 13 March 2025**

An additional two contingency night shifts may be worked on **Wednesday 19 and Thursday 20 March 2025** should there be delays due to operational or weather impacts.

If contingency shifts are required, [livetraffic.com](https://www.livetraffic.com) and electronic messaging signs in the area will be updated to reflect work occurring on these dates. Directly impacted residents will be notified separately.

For the safety of the community and workers and to minimise impacts to road users, work will be carried out on each of these nights between **6pm and 7am**. A section of Jervis Bay Road will be closed on these nights from **9pm to 5am**.

Work is subject to weather conditions, and we will keep the community informed of any changes to this schedule.

#### Temporary traffic changes

During the work hours there will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work area is safe. Motorists are advised to drive to conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.

During this night work, motorists using this detour should allow 15 minutes' additional travel time.

#### Detour

**Between 9pm and 5am** on these nights, Jervis Bay Road will be closed between the Princes Highway and Gardner Road. Residential and emergency services access will be maintained for properties within the closed section of Jervis Bay Road.

During the road closure, detours will be in place. Northbound and southbound traffic wishing to access Vincentia, Huskisson and other villages to the east of the highway will detour via the Princes Highway onto Island Point Road then onto The Wool Road.



## What will this mean for you?

Our work may be noisy at times, however we will minimise these impacts by using non-tonal reversing beepers on equipment, turning machinery off when not in use and carrying out

noisier works early during the night shift. Noise levels will be monitored throughout the night.

Emergency services have been notified and provisions have been made to enable quick access to the area if required. We thank you for your patience while this work takes place.
