Investigation work on the M5 Westbound upgrade between Moorebank Avenue and Hume Highway from Monday 7 July.

The M5 Motorway Westbound traffic upgrade from Moorebank Avenue to Hume Highway and the Moorebank Avenue interchange will reduce congestion and improve the efficiency and safety of the road network for all road users.

What work are we doing?

We will carry out drainage investigation works during the night with some activities during the day. The work will occur at several locations along the M5 Motorway, between Moorebank Avenue and the Hume Highway.

Work includes:

- Establishing temporary traffic control
- Investigation of stormwater drainage

Where will the work happen?

We will be on site for investigation works for 8 weeks, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be from **7:30am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday between 8am and 1pm.** Our night work hours will be from **9pm to 5am Sunday to Friday**.

When will we be working

We will be working a combination of day and night shifts ongoing between 7 July and 31 August 2025, weather permitting.

How will this affect me

The out of hours work may occasionally be noisy, however, TfNSW will make every effort to minimise the impact for residents by carrying out noisier work before midnight, turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and directing lights away from properties where possible.

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- Noise from machinery and equipment.
