



Macquarie Fields Station Upgrade – Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

August 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Macquarie Fields Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Continuing concrete work for the new lifts, footbridge, stairs and retaining walls
- Commencement of service relocations to enable the removal of the entry canopies
- Installation of ground pile footings to support widening of Platform 1 around the new lift

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Railway Parade, in and around Macquarie Fields Station, and within our site compound.

In August, standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

Out-of-hours work

We'll be working from **6am until 6pm on Saturday 9 August and Saturday 30 August** during planned trackwork on the freight line, when the freight trains will not be running.

Directly impacted residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Concrete trucks and pumps entering and exiting the worksites.
- Mobile cranes and delivery trucks to lift materials in and out of the worksites.

There will be some temporary changes for pedestrians and cyclists when we're working next to footpaths and at the station entrance. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist.

Important changes to ramp access

To support the upgrade, the ramp connecting the station forecourt to Platform 2 will be **closed from Tuesday 26 August** until the new ramp is constructed and opened in 2026. The stairs will remain available. We recommend customers who require ramp or lift access visit transportnsw.info for information on their next nearest accessible station ahead of their journey.

During the ramp closure, the entry forecourt will be temporarily narrowed with fencing to support construction activities. Access to the kiss and ride zone and the bus stop will be maintained at all times.

Changes to accessible parking

We will be relocating four accessible parking spaces further north on Railway Parade from **Tuesday 26 August 2025 until mid-2026**. This will enable the station building extension work to start. Alternative commuter parking is available in the Council commuter car park on Railway Parade.



We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding as we work to improve station accessibility.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Reducing noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
- Providing traffic controllers or signage to direct pedestrians.
