



Night work and traffic changes on Mamre Road during April 2025

Mamre Road upgrade

April 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of Wianamatta Country as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

What work are we doing this month?

Work will continue at night for up to **14 shifts** between **Tuesday 1 April** and **Wednesday 30 April** to:

- investigate, relocate and install utilities and stormwater drainage
- clear trees and vegetation within work areas
- remove, widen and repair road surfaces
- deliver and remove equipment from work areas and site compounds/stockpile yards as needed.

Before we begin working at night, we will let nearby residents know the exact dates.

We will also move traffic slightly to the east on both lanes going in either direction, from **late April**, between Solander Drive and Banks Drive, weather and program permitting.

Upcoming day work activities

Other work activities will continue during standard construction hours. You may see us on site:

- investigating, locating and marking where underground utility services are located
- relocating water, sewer, electricity, gas and telecommunications infrastructure
- excavating to prepare for building the new lanes
- importing and stockpiling material for construction work
- constructing temporary and permanent road surfaces and access roads

- saw cutting and removing existing road surface, kerbs, and islands
- removing old and installing new line marking.

Our work schedule

Working at night helps us to maintain safety for road users and our workers. It also aims to keep people moving during peak travel times.

Our night shift hours will be from **6pm to 7am**, between **Monday night and Saturday morning**. We will work no more than two consecutive nights, three nights a week, and no more than 10 nights a month at the same location. A map showing our work area is on the next page.

Where possible, we will work during the day, from **7am to 6pm** between **Monday and Friday**, and from **8am to 1pm** on **Saturday**. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise impacts to nearby residents by:

- arranging the work in stages at different locations
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- directing lighting towers away from properties when working at night
- We will also have water trucks on site to reduce dust.



What equipment will we use?

During this work, we may use:

- excavators, graders, rollers, bobcats, backhoes, mobile cranes and boring rigs.
- asphalt pavers, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, road saws, chainsaws, hand power tools
- lighting towers, elevated working platforms, generators, welders and metal cutting equipment.

Traffic changes

There will be lane closures in place along Mamre Road during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
