## Manly Cove West project

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the Northern Beaches on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

In December 2024 a new temporary mixed-use space was open for the community to enjoy in Manly.

### What work are we doing?

Over the coming weeks new seating, planter boxes, lighting and sandstone blocks will be installed in the public area to create a welcoming space for people to gather and enjoy the harbour while final planning for the sites revitalisation is completed.

### When and where we'll be working

Subject to weather and maritime conditions, work on site will start from **mid-June to late July** and is expected to take about four weeks to complete. Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm, Saturday**.

Equipment to be used includes hammer drill, hand tools, and utility vehicles.
